Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOFS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

I, Raymond Henry Beers, Secretary for Labour, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Factories and Shops Acts, hereby make and issue the following adjusted Determination of the Wages Board referred to hereunder showing adjusted rates and prices to operate from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in August, 1950.

Apprentices.

Improvers. One apprentice to every one male worker receiving not less than the minimum wage.

An indenture of apprenticeship has been prescribed by the Board.

Such number of improvers as together with the number of apprentices does not exceed three to every adult worker receiving not less than the minimum wage.
