ACT OF PARLIAMENT.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

I, THE Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, do hereby declare that I have this day assented, in His Majesty's name, to the Bill passed by the Parliament of the said State, the title whereof is hereunder set forth, that is to say:—

No. 5565. "An Act to make Temporary Provision with respect to the Egg and Egg Pulp Marketing Board."

Egg and Egg Pulp Marketing Board Act 1951. SUSPENDING THE MEMBERS OF THE EGG AND EGG PULP MARKETING BOARD.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by sub-section (1) of section 2 of the *Egg and Egg Pulp Marketing Board Act 1951* it is enacted that the Governor in Council may by Proclamation suspend the members of the Egg and Egg Pulp Marketing Board from office for such period or periods as he thinks fit, but so that such suspension shall not continue beyond a day being three months after the commencement of this Act: Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation hereby suspend the under-mentioned members of the Egg and Egg Pulp Marketing Board from office for a period of three (3) months:—

APPOINTING A PERSON TO BE THE MANAGER OF THE EGG AND EGG PULP MARKETING BOARD.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by sub-section (1) of section 2 of the *Egg and Egg Pulp Marketing Board Act 1951* it is enacted that the Governor in Council may by Proclamation—

(a) suspend the members of the Egg and Egg Pulp Marketing Board from office for such period or periods as he thinks fit, but so that such suspension shall not continue beyond a day being three months after the commencement of this Act;

(b) appoint a person (whether or not one of the members suspended as aforesaid) to be the manager of the said Board during the suspension of the members as aforesaid:

And whereas the Governor in Council by Proclamation has suspended the members of the Egg and Egg Pulp Marketing Board from office for a period of three (3) months: Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation hereby appoint GEORGE ROBERT BOULTON to be the manager of the Egg and Egg Pulp Marketing Board during the period of suspension of the members of the said Board.
