Prices Regulation Acts.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 307.

RUBBER GARDEN HOSE.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Decontrol Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 307.

Revocation.

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 106 is hereby revoked.

Definition.

In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—
 "metropolitan area" means all that area comprised within a
 radius of 20 miles from the General Post Office,
 Melbourne.

Maximum Price.

- 4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any type or size for rubber garden hose, specified in the Schedule to this Order, may be sold by retail to be—
 - (a) in the metropolitan area—the price specified in the fourth column of the Schedule;
 - (b) outside the metropolitan area—the price specified in the fourth column of the Schedule plus one halfpenny per foot

. Fixation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

5. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which rubber garden hose specified in a notice given in pursuance of this clause may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Prices Decontrol Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

Prices Regulation Acts. PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 308.

SAFETY MATCHES.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred on me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Decontrol Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

- 1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 308.
- Revocation.
 2. Prices Regulation Order No. 259 is hereby revoked.

Definitions.

- 3. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears-
 - "Geelong area" means all that area of Victoria comprised within a radius of 5 miles from the principal post office at Geelong;
 - "metropolitan area" means all that area of Victoria comprised within a radius of 25 miles from the General Post Office at Melbourne.

Sales by Manufacturers.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which safety matches may be sold by any manufacturer thereof or his agent to be the price fixed by me by notice in writing to such manufacturer or agent.

Sales by Wholesale by Persons other than Manufacturers.

- 5. I fix and declare the maximum price at which safety matches may be sold by wholesale by any person other than the manufacturer thereof or such manufacturer's agent to be 18s. per gross.
- Provided that, where such safety matches are sold from stock purchased from the manufacturer thereof in "loose" gross packages, then the maximum price specified in the previous provisions of this paragraph shall be reduced to 17s. 11d. per gross.

Provided further that, where payment of the purchase price of such safety matches is made—

- (i) before delivery, on delivery, or not more than ten days
 from date of delivery, such maximum price shall be
 reduced by 3 per centum thereof;
- (ii) more than ten days after delivery, but not later than the last day of the calendar month following the month during which delivery is made, such maximum price shall be reduced by 2½ per centum thereof;
- (iii) at any time during the second calendar month following the calendar month during which delivery is made, such maximum price shall be reduced by 1½ per centum thereof.
- 6. The maximum prices fixed by the previous provisions of this Order for the sale of safety matches are maximum prices for the sale of safety matches inclusive of delivery as follows:—
 - (a) Where the purchaser's place of business is situated in Geelong area or metropolitan area—delivery "free into store";
 - (b) Where the purchaser's place of business is not situated in Geelong area or metropolitan area—delivery "free on rail" Geelong area or Melbourne area as the case may be.
- 7. I declare the maximum price at which safety matches may be sold by wholesale by any person other than a manufacturer or manufacturer's agent on any other terms of delivery than those specified in paragraphs 5 and 6 of this Order to be such price as is fixed by me by notice in writing to such person and until such notice in writing aforesaid is given the maximum price at which any safety matches shall be sold by wholesale by such person shall be 16s. 3d. per gross.

Sales by Retail.

8. I fix and declare the maximum prices at which safety matches may be sold by retail to be the prices specified in the Schedule to this Order.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 309.

Toilet Preparations and Cosmetics—Sales by Retail.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Decontrol Commissioner, hereby make the following Order.

Citation

- This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 309.
 Definitions.
- 2. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears-
 - "specified goods" means toilet preparations and cosmetics, and without affecting the generality thereof includes lipsticks, rouges, face, hand and body creams, face, body, and hand lotions, face, bath, foot, and talcum powders (compressed or loose), suntan lotions, bath salts, mascaras, eye shadows,

eye-brow pencils, nail polishes or lacquers and removers of same, hair oils, hair shampoos, hair-waving lotions, hair dyes, hair rinses, hair restorers, perfumery, eau de Cologne and toilet waters, and all other goods of a similar nature except shaving creams, shaving soaps, dentifrices, and soaps;

"wholesale price" means in relation to any specified goods the maximum wholesale selling price which, under the provisions of any Prices Regulation Order made under the Prices Regulation Acts, is payable by any retail trader to the supplier of such goods, exclusive of sales tax;

"retail trader" means in relation to the sale of any specified goods a person who purchases such goods and ordinarily sells them to persons who purchase them for use or consumption;

Maximum Prices-Sales by Retail.

- 3. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any specified goods may be sold by a retail trader to be the sum of—
 - (a) the wholesale price of those goods;
 - (b) a margin on the wholesale price-
 - (i) at the rate of 50 per centum; or
 - (ii) at the rate of margin at which on the 18th July, 1951, he sold similar specified goods or where he did not sell any similar specified goods on that day on the last day prior to the 18th July, 1951, on which he did sell them—

whichever rate is the lesser;

(c) sales tax paid or payable in respect of such goods.

Fixation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

4. Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing provisions of this Order, I delcare the maximum prices at which any of the specified goods may be sold by any person to whom a notice in pursuance of this clause is given, to be such price as is fixed by the Prices Decontrol Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.
