DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

Clauses, other than clauses 2 and 17 of the said Determination shall remain in force, provided that, to the weekly earnings of each pieceworker shall be added the sum of twenty-two shillings. Where less than 40 hours is worked in any week by any pieceworker, a proportionate amount of such sum of twenty-two shillings shall be added in lieu thereof.
