Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE SHOPS BOARD No. 17 (TOBACCONISTS).

Note.—This Determination applies to the following parts of Victoria, viz.:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts and the Orders in Council thereunder; the Cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Geelong West, Warrnambool and Newtown and Chilwell; and the Boroughs of Eaglehawk and Sebastopol.

In accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person employed in a Tobacconist's shop" has made the following Determination, namely:—

1. That as from the 1st March, 1951, clause 7 of the Determination of this Board published in Government Gazette No. 4 of the 3rd January, 1951, shall be amended to read:—

SUNDAYS AND HOLIDAYS.

7. Double time shall be the rate for all work done on Sundays, New Year's Day, Australia Day, Labour Day, Good Friday, Easter Saturday, Easter Monday, King's Birthday, 9th May, 1951, 13th November, 1951, Christmas Day, and Boxing Day, but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, this rate shall be payable for work done only on the day so substituted.

All employees shall be entitled to the above-named holidays without deduction of pay.
