Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE CEMENT BOARD.

Norm.—This Determination applies to the whole of the State of Victoria.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board which now has power to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, business, or occupation of—

- (a) making Portland cement,
- (b) quarrying or preparing the raw materials for Portland coment,
- (c) extracting potash salts from the by-products of Portland cement"

has made the following Determination namely:-

1. That as from the 1st April, 1951, clause 9 of the Determination of this Board published in Government Gazette No. 36 of the 22nd January, 1951, shall be amended to read:—

SPECIAL RATES.

9. Work done on Sundays by day workers (other than underground drainers) shall be paid for at the rate of double time, and double time shall be the rate payable for work done by all persons on New Year's Day, Australia Day, Labour Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Anzac Day, King's Birthday, 9th May, 1951, 13th November, 1951, Christmas Day, and Boxing Day, but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the abovenamed holidays, the special rate shall be payable only for work done on the day so substituted.
