Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE PLASTER OF PARIS BOARD.

Note.—This Determination applies to the whole of the State of Victoria.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, or business

- (a) making plaster of paris;
- (b) excavating or preparing the raw materials for plaster of paris";

las made the following Determination, namely:-

1. That as from the 15th April, 1951, clause 11 of the Determination of this Board published in Government Gazette No. 113 of the 30th January, 1951, shall be amended to read:—

SPECIAL RATES.

11. Double time shall be the rate payable for all work done on Sundays, New Year's Day, Australia Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Labour Day, Anzac Day, King's Birthday, 9th May, 1951, 13th November, 1951, Melbourne Cup Day (Metropolitan District only), Christmas Day, and Boxing Day; but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the special rates shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.
