Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE LIFT BOARD.

NOTE.—This Determination applies to the whole of the State of Victoria.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, business, or occupation of a lift attendant" has made the following Determination, namely:—

1. That as from the 18th April, 1951, clauses 8 and 18 of the Determination published in *Government Gazette* No. 78 of the 26th January, 1951, shall be amended to read:—

SPECIAL RATES FOR SUNDAYS AND PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.

8. Lift attendants (including casuals) employed in hotels, clubs, coffee palaces, restaurants, or hospitals shall be paid at the rate of time and a half for work done on Sundays, New Year's Day, Australia Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Labour Day, Anzac Day, 9th May, 1951, 13th November, 1951, Christmas Day, and Boxing Day; and all other lift attendants (including casuals) shall be paid double time for work done on Sundays, New Year's Day, Australia Day, Good Friday, Easter Saturday, Easter Monday, Labour Day, Anzac Day, King's Birthday, 9th May, 1951, 13th November, 1951, Melbourne Cup Day (within the Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts and the Orders in Council thereunder), Christmas Day, and Boxing Day; but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the special rate shall be payable only for the day so substituted.

PAYMENT FOR HOLIDAYS.

18. All employees (other than those employed in hotels, clubs, coffee palaces, restaurants, and hospitals) not being paid casual rates shall be entitled to the following holidays without deduction of pay:—New Year's Day, Australia Day, Good Friday, Easter Saturday, Easter Monday, Labour Day, Anzac Day, King's Birthday, 9th May, 1951, 13th November, 1951, Melbourne Cup Day (within the Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts and the Orders in Council thereunder), Christmas Day, and Boxing Day.
