Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE SHOPS BOARD No. 8 (DAIRY PRODUCE AND COOKED MEAT).

Note.—This Determination applies to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Act 1928 (No. 3677) and the Orders in Council thereunder; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Geelong West, Warrnambool, and Newtown and Chilwell; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk and Sebastopol.

N accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons employed in the trade of a seller of Dairy Produce or Cooked Meat," has made the following Determination, namely:—

1. That as from the 1st March, 1951, clause 8 of the Determination of this Board published in Government Gazette No. 27 of the 15th January, 1951, shall be amended to read:—

SUNDAYS AND HOLIDAYS.

8. Treble time shall be the rate for all work done on Easter Saturday, and double time for all work done on Sundays, New Yoar's Day, Australia Day, Labour Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, King's Birthday, 9th May, 1951, 13th November, 1951, Christmas Day, and Soxing Day, and within the Metropolitan District Melbourne Show Day and Melbourne Cup Day. If any other day be by Act af Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the rate shall be payable for work done only on the day*so substituted.

All employees shall be entitled to the above-named holidays without deduction of pay.
