One apprentice to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than 205s. 6d. per week of 40 hours, or the prescribed piecework prices.

APPRENTICES.
Feather Duster or Mop Sections.

One apprentice to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than 205a. 6d. per week of 40 hours.

IMPROVERS.
Feather Duster Making Section.

Two male improvers to every worker receiving not less than 205s. 6d. per week

of 40 hours.

Two female improvers to every female worker receiving not less than 149s, per week of 40 hours.

Mop Making Section.

Two male improvers to every worker receiving not less than 205s. 6d. per week of

40 hours.

Two female improvers to every female worker receiving not less than 149s. per week of 40 hours. Broom Section.

One improver to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than

205s. 6d. per week of 40 hours, or the prescribed piece-work prices.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination as amended on the 13th April, 1951, shall remain in force provided that in clause 14 the amount of 80s. 6d, wherever appearing shall be increased to 107s. 6d.
