PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 347.

NEW CORNSACKS.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, William Douglas Smith, Acting Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

*Citation.*

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 347.

*Revocation.*

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 161 is hereby revoked.

*Definitions and Interpretation.*

3. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—

"Distributor" means, in relation to the sale of any new cornsacks for use as containers of wheat or barley, a person appointed by the Australian Wheat Board to distribute new cornsacks for such purposes;

"Wholesale Merchant" means, in relation to the sale of new cornsacks for use other than as containers of wheat or barley, a person who has purchased those cornsacks from the Australian Wheat Board;

"Cost of transport" means, in relation to the sale of new cornsacks, the cost of transport (if any) incurred by the seller in transporting the goods from the point of delivery to his place of business and recorded on an invoice or docket delivered in relation thereto;

"Point of delivery" means, in relation to the sale of new cornsacks, the place at which liability for payment of transport charges in conveying such new cornsacks to his place of business passed to the seller from the person from whom he purchased them.

*Maximum Prices—New Cornsacks for Use as Containers of Wheat or Barley.*

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which new cornsacks, for use as containers of wheat or barley, may be sold to be 69s. 6d. per dozen, plus cost of transport (if any), plus a margin at the rate specified in the First Schedule to this Order.

*Maximum Prices—New Cornsacks for Use other than as Containers of Wheat or Barley.*

5. I fix and declare the maximum price at which new cornsacks, for use other than as containers of wheat or barley, may be sold to be 69s. 6d. per dozen, plus cost of transport (if any), plus a margin at the rate specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.

*Fixation of Maximum Price by Notice.*

6. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which new cornsacks, specified in a notice given in pursuance of this clause, may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given, to be such price as is fixed by the Prices Commissioner, in writing, to that person.

## PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 348.

AERATED WATERS, MINERAL WATERS, MILK DRINKS, FRUIT DRINKS—  
RETAIL SALES—GIPPSLAND AREA.

I, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, William Douglas Smith, Acting Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

*Citation.*

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 348.

*Application.*

2. (a) This Order shall not apply to sales (not being sales by the bottle), made by a licensed victualler.

(b) Nothing contained in Prices Regulation Order No. 217, insofar as it relates to sales by retail, shall apply to any goods the maximum prices of which are fixed under this Order.

*Definitions.*

3. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—

"Gippsland area" means all that area of Victoria comprised in the Town of Sale, the Borough of Wonthaggi, and the Shires of—

"Pure fruit drink" means any drink made from fruit juice extracted from fruit and wholly prepared on the premises of the vendor, with the addition of water or aerated water, and with or without the addition of any other ingredient;

"Fruit drink" means any drink made from fruit juice, cordial extract or syrup, with the addition of water, soda water or other aerated waters, and with or without the addition of any other ingredient;

"Ice cream soda" means any drink made from fruit juice, cordial extract or syrup, with the addition of aerated water, and a minimum of one serve of ice cream;

"Orange or lemon squash" means any drink made from orange or lemon (as the case may be) fruit juice, cordial extract or syrup, with the addition of soda water or other aerated water;

"Milk drink" means any drink of which milk is the sole or principal ingredient;

"Glass" means glass or other similar container;

"Oz." means fluid ounce or ounces, as the case may be.

*Bottled Aerated Waters, Fruit Drinks, and Mineral Waters—Sales by the Bottle.*

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which bottled aerated waters, mineral waters, table waters and fruit drinks, of the description set out in the third column of the First Schedule to this Order and manufactured by the persons set out in the first column of such Schedule may be sold by retail in the Gippsland area to be the prices specified in the fourth column of such Schedule. Provided that, where at the request of the purchaser a bottle containing not more than 13 oz. is opened for the purpose of consumption on the premises of the vendor, to the price applicable thereto in accordance with the fourth column of the Schedule to this Order, there may be added one halfpenny.

*Sales other than by the Bottle.*

5. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any of the items specified in the Second Schedule to this Order may be sold other than by the bottle to be—

- (a) where delivery is accepted at the counter, bar, or self-service table on the premises of the vendor, the price set out in the second column of the said Schedule; or
- (b) where the items specified are served at tables or in foyer bars situated within a theatre or public hall, the price set out in the third column of the said Schedule.

Where at the request of the purchaser, a milk drink comprising the whole or portion of the contents of a bottle of milk together with flavouring syrup is supplied in the bottle, the maximum retail price shall be the sum of—

- (a) the prevailing retail price of such bottle of milk, and
- (b) flavouring syrup calculated at the rate of 1½d. per ounce.
