DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

A Zone Manager shall, in addition to his ordinary wage, be entitled to the following allowance for each additional theatret, theatrette, or concert hall supervised:—

£1 per week with a maximum of £4 per week.
Second Schedule.

15s. per week with a maximum of £3 per week.
Third Schedule.

10s. per week with a maximum of £2 per week.
Fourth Schedule.

7s. 6d. per week with a maximum of £1 10s. per week.

(b) Casual Employees.

A casual employee is one engaged and paid as such. A casual employee for working ordinary time shall be paid per bour one-fortieth of the appropriate weekly wage with the addition of 20 per cent. with a minimum payment as for 4 hours. Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
