PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 417.

AERATED WATERS, MINERAL WATERS, TABLE WATERS, AND FRUIT DRINKS,
RETAIL—OUTER METROPOLITAN AND MORNINGTON PENINSULA AREAS.

I N pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Commissioner for the State of Victoria, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 417.

Revocation.

2. (a) Prices Regulation Order No. 336 is hereby revoked.
(b) Nothing contained in Prices Regulation Order No. 217 insofar as it relates to sales by retail shall apply to any goods the maximum prices for which are fixed under this Order.

Application.

3. This Order shall not apply to sales (not being sales by the bottle) made by a licensed victualler.

Definitions.

4. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—
“Outer Metropolitan and Mornington Peninsula Areas” means all that area of Victoria outside a radius of 27 miles from the General Post Office, Melbourne, comprised in the Shires of—

Broadmeadows;
Bulla;
Dandenong;
Doncaster and Templestowe;
Eltham;
Fern Tree Gully;
Flinders;
Frankston and Hastings;
Gisborne;
Lilydale;
Melton;
Mornington;
Werribee;
Whittlesea.

“Oz.” means fluid ounce or ounces, as the case may be.

Bottled Aerated Waters, Aerated Fruit Drinks, Table Waters, and Mineral Waters—Sales by the Bottle.

5. I fix and declare the maximum price at which bottled aerated waters, mineral waters, table waters, and fruit drinks, of the description set out in the second column of the Schedule to this Order and manufactured by the person set out in the first column of such Schedule, may be sold by retail in the Outer Metropolitan and Mornington Peninsula Areas, to be the prices specified in the third column of such Schedule.

Provided that, where at the request of the purchaser, a bottle containing not more than 13 oz. is opened for the purpose of consumption on the premises of the vendor, to the price applicable thereto, in accordance with the third column of the Schedule to this Order, there may be added One half-penny.

Refund of Deposits on Bottles.

6. Where any sum lodged as a deposit on a bottle or bottles or other container containing any goods, the maximum price of which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order is accepted by the vendor of such goods, the vendor shall, upon the return of such bottle or bottles or other containers in respect of which such deposit was lodged, refund such deposit in full to the person who lodged such deposit.

Variation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

7. Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any aerated waters, mineral waters, table waters, and fruit drinks specified in a notice given in pursuance of this paragraph may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

Exhibition of Price List.

8. Every person who sells or has for sale by retail any goods, the maximum price of which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, shall exhibit and keep exhibited in a prominent position in his place of business or, if he has more than one place of business, in each of his places of business, in the form of a price list and in such a manner as to be easily legible to persons contemplating making any purchase or conducting any business at his place or places of business, particulars of the maximum prices fixed by or under the provisions of this Order for the sale by him of those goods, such notice to show separately the deposit charge (if any) for any container included in the selling price so exhibited.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 418.
BOVINE HIDES AND SKINS.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Commissioner for the State of Victoria, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 418.

Application.

2. This Order shall apply to bovine hides and skins produced in Victoria or Tasmania.

Maximum Prices—Amendment.

3. Prices Regulation Order No. 223 dated the fourth day of April, 1951, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the sixth day of April, 1951, is hereby amended by deleting paragraph 4 and inserting in its stead the following:—

" 4. I fix and declare the maximum price in pence per pound at which any grade, class, type, or weight of bovine hide or skin or lot thereof specified in the Schedule to this Order may be sold or offered for sale by any person to be the price in pence per pound specified therein, plus forty-nine (49) per centum of such price."

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 419.
BOVINE HIDES AND SKINS.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Commissioner for the State of Victoria, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 419.

Application.

2. This Order shall apply only to bovine hides and skins produced elsewhere than in Victoria or Tasmania.

Maximum Prices—Amendment.

3. Prices Regulation Order No. 224 dated the fourth day of April, 1951, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the sixth day of April, 1951, is hereby amended by deleting paragraph 4 and inserting in its stead the following:—

“ 4. I fix and declare the maximum price in pence per pound at which any grade, class, type, or weight of bovine hides or skins or lot thereof specified in the Schedules to this Order may be sold or offered for sale by any person to be—

- (a) in respect of bovine hides or skins produced in New South Wales the price in pence per pound specified in the First Schedule to this Order, plus forty-six (46) per centum thereof;
- (b) in respect of bovine hides or skins produced in South Australia the price in pence per pound specified in the Second Schedule to this Order, plus fifty-three (53) per centum thereof;
- (c) in respect of bovine hides or skins produced in Queensland the price in pence per pound specified in the Third Schedule to this Order, plus fifty-six (56) per centum thereof;
- (d) in respect of bovine hides or skins produced in Western Australia the price in pence per pound specified in the Fourth Schedule to this Order, plus sixty (60) per centum thereof.”

I fix and declare the maximum prices at which leather of any of the kinds or descriptions specified in the Schedule to this Order may be sold by Daniel Lissek, Harry Lissek, and Joe Lissek, carrying on business under the name of Daniel Lissek and Co., at 115 Vere-street, Collingwood, or any of them, to be such prices as may be fixed by me by a notice in writing.

Exhibition of Price List.

3. Daniel Lissek and Co., which sells or has for sale any leather the maximum price of which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, shall exhibit and keep exhibited in a prominent position in their place of business, or if they have more than one place of business, in each of their places of business, in the form of a price list and in such a manner as to be easily legible to persons contemplating making any purchase or conducting any business, particulars of the maximum prices fixed by or under the provisions of this Order.
