Prices Regulation Acts.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 340.—PROCESSED MILK
PRODUCTS—WHOLESALE PRICES.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 340.

Revocation.

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 291 is hereby revoked.

Definitions and Interpretations.

3. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—
“Metropolitan Area” means all that area of Victoria comprised within a radius of 25 miles from the General Post Office, Melbourne.
“Ton” means 2,240 pounds weight avoirdupois.

Maximum Prices—Sales by Wholesale.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which processed milk products of the description specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order may be sold by wholesale in Victoria to be the price set out opposite such goods in the second column of that Schedule.

Discounts.

5. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Order, where any person has customarily allowed, in relation to sales by wholesale of any of the processed milk products specified in the Schedule to this Order, any difference in price—

- (a) to any person or to any person included in any class of persons;
- (b) in respect of sales of certain quantities;
- (c) in respect of sales under certain conditions of sale or upon certain terms of payment;

the maximum prices fixed by or under this Order, in respect of those processed milk products shall, in the case of sales to any such person or persons, or of such quantities or under such conditions or upon such terms of payment, be reduced by allowance of that difference.

Fixation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

6. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any processed milk product specified in a notice given in pursuance of this clause may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.
