Prices Regulation Acts.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 448.

IMPORTED GALVANIZED PIPING.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 448.

Definitions.

2. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears:—

“Cost” means, in relation to the sale of any imported galvanized piping, the purchase price paid or payable to the supplier of such goods;

“Landed cost” means, in relation to the sale of any imported galvanized piping, the aggregate of:—

- (i) The purchase price paid or payable after deduction of trade discount but before deduction of any cash discount;
- (ii) inland carriage charges;
- (iii) outside packing charges;
- (iv) overseas office or forwarding agent's commission actually incurred (but not in excess of 3¼ per centum of the gross invoice price of the goods after deduction of trade discount but before deduction of cash discount);
- (v) bill of lading and shipping charges;
- (vi) insurance and freight paid (but not in excess of current standard sea freight rates);
- (vii) exchange and bank fees actually incurred (but not in the case of exchange in excess of mail steamer sight draft rates and in the case of bank fees three-eighths of one per cent.);
- (viii) duty and primage paid;

- (ix) wharfage and stacking charges paid;
- (x) harbour dues and Stevedoring Commission levy paid;
- (xi) Customs entry and Custom agent's charges paid (but not including any charges for costing or any percentage surcharge on cost); and
- (xii) cartage actually incurred in transporting goods from wharf to store or from wharf to bond only (but not in excess of current standard Master Carriers' rates).

"Imported" means, in respect of any galvanized piping, any galvanized piping which is manufactured outside the Commonwealth of Australia.

"Wholesale trader" means, in relation to the sale of any galvanized piping, a person who purchases or imports these goods and ordinarily sells them to persons who purchase for resale.

"Retail trader" means, in relation to the sale of any galvanized piping, a person who purchases or imports these goods and ordinarily sells them to persons who purchase for use or consumption.

"Metropolitan Area" means all that area comprised within a radius of twenty miles from the General Post Office, Melbourne.

Maximum Rate for Supply of Service by Indent Agent.

3. I fix and declare the maximum rate at which any person may supply the service of acting as an indent agent in connexion with the bringing into Victoria of imported galvanized piping to be 2½ per centum of the landed cost of such piping.

Maximum Prices—Sales by Wholesale.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which imported galvanized piping may be sold by a wholesale trader, who has imported such piping through an indent agent, to be as follows:—

- (1) Where delivery is made to the purchaser ex wharf at Melbourne, the sum of—
 - (i) the landed cost of the piping;
 - (ii) two and a half per centum of the sum of item (1);
 - (iii) five per centum of the sum of items (i) and (ii).
- (2) Where delivery is made to the purchaser within the Metropolitan Area ex wholesale trader's store, the sum of—
 - (i) the landed cost of the piping;
 - (ii) two and a half per centum of the sum of item (1);
 - (iii) seven and a half per centum of the sum of items (i) and (ii).
- (3) Where delivery is made to the purchaser at the expense of the wholesale trader at a place outside the Metropolitan Area and the piping was delivered direct from the wharf at Melbourne, the sum of—
 - (i) the landed cost of the piping;
 - (ii) two and a half per centum of the sum of item (1);
 - (iii) five per centum of the sum of items (1) and (ii);
 - (iv) plus the cost actually incurred in respect of and properly attributable to the transport of that imported galvanized piping from the wharf at Melbourne to the place of delivery to the purchaser.
- (4) Where delivery is made to the purchaser at the expense of the wholesale trader at a place outside the Metropolitan Area, and the piping was delivered direct from the wholesale trader's store, the sum of—
 - (i) the landed cost of the piping;
 - (ii) two and a half per centum of the sum of item (1);
 - (iii) seven and a half per centum of the sum of items (1) and (ii);
 - (iv) plus the cost actually incurred in respect of and properly attributable to the transport of that imported galvanized piping from the wholesale trader's store to the place of delivery to the purchaser.

5. I fix and declare the maximum price at which imported galvanized piping may be sold by a wholesale trader, who has imported such piping direct, to be as follows:—

- (1) Where delivery is made to the purchaser ex wharf at Melbourne, the sum of—
 - (i) the landed cost of the piping;
 - (ii) seven and a half per centum of the sum of item (i).
- (2) Where delivery is made to the purchaser within the Metropolitan Area ex the wholesale trader's store, the sum of—
 - (i) the landed cost of the piping;
 - (ii) ten per centum of the sum of item (i).
- (3) Where delivery is made to the purchaser at the expense of the wholesale trader at a place outside the Metropolitan Area and the piping was delivered direct from the wharf at Melbourne, the sum of—
 - (i) the landed cost of the piping;
 - (ii) seven and a half per centum of the sum of item (i);
 - (iii) plus the cost actually incurred in respect of and properly attributable to the transport of that imported galvanized piping from the wharf at Melbourne to the place of delivery to the purchaser.
- (4) Where delivery is made to the purchaser at the expense of the wholesale trader at a place outside the Metropolitan Area and the piping was delivered direct from the wholesale trader's store, the sum of—
 - (i) the landed cost of the piping;
 - (ii) ten per centum of the sum of item (i);
 - (iii) plus the cost actually incurred in respect of and properly attributable to the transport of that imported galvanized piping from the wholesale trader's store to the place of delivery to the purchaser.

Maximum Prices—Sales by Retail.

6. I fix and declare the maximum price at which imported galvanized piping may be sold by a retail trader, who has imported such piping through an indent agent, to be as follows:—

- (1) Where the place of delivery of the piping to the purchaser is within the Metropolitan Area, the sum of—
 - (i) the landed cost of the piping;
 - (ii) two and a half per centum of the sum of item (i);
 - (iii) eighteen per centum of the sum of items (i) and (ii).
- (2) Where the place of delivery to the purchaser is outside the Metropolitan Area, the sum of—
 - (i) the landed cost of the piping;
 - (ii) two and a half per centum of the sum of item (i);
 - (iii) eighteen per centum of the sum of items (i) and (ii);
 - (iv) plus the cost actually incurred in respect of and properly attributable to the transport of that imported galvanized piping from the wharf at Melbourne to the place of delivery to the purchaser.

7. I fix and declare the maximum price at which imported galvanized piping may be sold by a retail trader who has purchased such piping from a wholesale trader, to be as follows:—

- (1) In respect of piping delivered to that retail trader ex wharf at Melbourne—
 - (a) for sales within the Metropolitan Area, the sum of—
 - (i) the purchase price paid or payable to the wholesale trader for such piping; and
 - (ii) twelve and a half per centum of item (i).
 - (b) for sales outside the Metropolitan Area, the sum of—
 - (i) the purchase price paid or payable to the wholesale trader for such piping;
 - (ii) twelve and a half per centum of item (i);
 - (iii) the cost actually incurred by the retail trader in respect of and properly attributable to the transport of the piping from the Metropolitan Area to the retail trader's place of business.

(2) In respect of piping delivered to that retail trader ex the wholesale trader's store—

- (a) for sales within the Metropolitan Area, the sum of—
 - (i) the purchase price paid or payable to the wholesale trader for such piping; and
 - (ii) ten per centum of item (i).
- (b) for sales outside the Metropolitan Area, the sum of—
 - (i) the purchase price paid or payable to the wholesale trader for such piping;
 - (ii) ten per centum of item (i); and
 - (iii) the cost actually incurred by the retail trader in respect of and properly attributable to the transport of the piping from the wholesale trader's store to the retail trader's place of business.

8. I fix and declare the maximum price at which imported galvanized piping may be sold by a retail trader, who has imported such piping direct, to be as follows:—

- (1) For sales within the Metropolitan Area, the sum of—
 - (i) the landed cost of the piping;
 - (ii) twenty-one per centum of the sum of item (i).
- (2) For sales outside the Metropolitan Area, the sum of—
 - (i) the landed cost of the piping;
 - (ii) twenty-one per centum of the sum of item (i).
 - (iii) plus the cost actually incurred in respect of and properly attributable to the transport of that imported galvanized piping from the wharf at Melbourne to the retail trader's place of business.

Exhibition of Price Tickets.

9. (1) Every person who sells or has for sale by retail any imported galvanized piping, the maximum price of which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, shall at all times whilst such goods are in his possession keep attached to or displayed with such goods a ticket or label setting forth his selling price thereof.

(2) Any ticket or label required by sub-paragraph (1) of this paragraph to be attached to or displayed with any goods shall be in such form as to be easily legible to any person inspecting or reviewing those goods and as to be properly associated with such goods.

Application for Maximum Prices.

10. Any person who purchases for resale any imported galvanized piping, for which a maximum price is not fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, shall not sell that imported galvanized piping unless and until that person has made a written request to the Commissioner to fix the maximum price at which that imported galvanized piping may be sold, and the Commissioner has fixed the maximum price accordingly.

Fixation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

11. (1) Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which imported galvanized piping specified in a notice given in pursuance of this paragraph may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

(2) All notices in writing given in pursuance of any Prices Regulation Order issued prior to this Order, which operate to fix a maximum price for the sale by any person of any imported galvanized piping lower than the maximum price fixed by the provisions of this Order and which are in force at the commencement of this Order, shall be deemed to have been given under this Order.

Delivery of Invoices.

12. Every person who sells imported galvanized piping shall deliver with those goods an invoice or docket specifying the following particulars:—

- (i) Name of seller;
- (ii) address of seller;
- (iii) date of sale;
- (iv) name of purchaser;
- (v) address of purchaser;
- (vi) quantity of imported galvanized piping sold;
- (vii) full description of goods showing gauge, width, and length;
- (viii) price at which these goods are sold.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 449.

AERATED WATERS, MINERAL WATERS, TABLE WATERS, FRUIT DRINKS—
RETAIL—SOUTH-WESTERN AREA.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Commissioner for the State of Victoria, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 449.

Revocation.

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 66 is hereby revoked.

Application.

3. (1) This Order shall not apply to sales (not being sales by the bottle) made by a licensed victualler.

(2) Nothing contained in Prices Regulation Order No. 217, insofar as it relates to sales by retail, shall apply to any goods the maximum prices of which are fixed by or under this Order.

Definitions.

4. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—

“South-Western Area” means all that area of Victoria comprised in:—

The City of Warrnambool.

The Towns of Ararat and Hamilton.

The Boroughs of—

Koroit, Portland.

Port Fairy,

And the Shires of—

Ararat, Mortlake,

Belfast, Mount Rouse,

Dundas, Portland,

Glenelg, Ripon,

Hampden, Wannon,

Heytesbury, Warrnambool.

Minhamite,

“oz.” means fluid ounce or ounces as the case may be.

*Bottled Aerated Waters, Aerated Fruit Drinks, and Mineral Waters.—
Sales by the Bottle.*

5. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any bottled aerated waters, aerated fruit drinks, or mineral waters manufactured by the persons set out in the first column of the Schedule to this Order and described in the third column thereto may be sold in the South-Western Area, to be the price set out in the fourth column of the said Schedule—

Provided that where at the request of the purchaser, a bottle containing not more than 13 oz. is opened for the purpose of consumption on the premises of the vendor, to the price applicable thereto in accordance with the fourth column of the Schedule to this Order, there may be added one halfpenny.

Refund of Deposits on Bottles.

6. Where any sum lodged as a deposit on a bottle or bottles or other containers of any goods, the maximum price of which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, is accepted by the vendor of such goods, the vendor shall, upon the return of such bottle or bottles or other containers in respect of which such deposit was lodged, refund such deposit in full to the person who lodged such deposit.

Variation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

7. Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any aerated waters, aerated fruit drinks, mineral waters or table waters specified in a notice given in pursuance of this clause may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

Exhibition of Price List.

8. Every person who sells or has for sale by retail any goods, the maximum price of which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, shall exhibit and keep exhibited in a prominent position in his place of business or, if he has more than one place of business in each

of his places of business, in the form of a price list and in such a manner as to be easily legible to persons contemplating making any purchase or conducting any business at his place or places of business, particulars of the maximum prices fixed by or under the provisions of this Order for the sale by him of those goods, such notice to show separately the deposit charge (if any) for any container included in the selling price so exhibited.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 450.

SEED POTATOES.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 450.

Revocation.

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 384 is hereby revoked.

Definitions.

3. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—

“Approved seed potatoes” means potatoes approved as suitable for seed by a duly authorized officer of the State Department of Agriculture.

“Certified seed potatoes” means potatoes accepted by a duly authorized officer of the State Department of Agriculture as certified seed potatoes.

“Primary wholesaler” in relation to the sale of seed potatoes means a person who purchases seed potatoes for the purpose of resale to another wholesaler whose normal business is to sell seed potatoes by wholesale.

“Secondary wholesaler” in relation to the sale of seed potatoes means a person who purchases seed potatoes from a primary wholesaler for the purpose of resale.

“By wholesale” means and refers to a sale of seed potatoes in lots of one bag or more.

“Ton” means a long ton of 2,240 lb. or a quantity of fifteen bags of seed potatoes each containing not less than 149 lb. weight.

"Lb." means pound avoirdupois or pounds avoirdupois as the case requires.

"Metropolitan Area" means all that area comprised within a radius of 20 miles from the General Post Office, Melbourne.

"Point of delivery" means, in relation to the sale of seed potatoes, the place at which liability for payment of transport charges in conveying such seed potatoes to his place of business passed to the seller from the person from whom he purchased them.

"Cost of transport" means, in relation to the transport of seed potatoes, cost of transport by rail (or, if rail transport is not available, any other service which may be available), but does not include any cost of transport which is not recorded on an invoice delivered by the seller, or in the case of sales by retail on an invoice delivered to the retail seller.

"Potato Marketing Board" means the Potato Marketing Board constituted under the *Marketing of Primary Products Act 1935* of the State of Victoria.

Sales by Growers.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which seed potatoes may be sold by growers to be—

- (1) In respect of approved seed potatoes—
 - (a) at the point of production, £30 per ton;
 - (b) at places other than the point of production, £30 per ton, plus properly incurred cost of transport from the point of production to the place of sale.
- (2) In respect of certified seed potatoes—
 - (a) at the point of production, £33 per ton;
 - (b) at places other than the point of production, £33 per ton, plus properly incurred cost of transport from the point of production to the place of sale.
- (3) In respect of seed potatoes other than approved or certified seed potatoes—
 - (a) at the point of production, £29 per ton;
 - (b) at places other than the point of production, £29 per ton, plus properly incurred cost of transport from the point of production to the place of sale.

Sales by the Potato Marketing Board.

5. I fix and declare the maximum price at which seed may be sold by the Potato Marketing Board to be—

- (1) In respect of approved seed potatoes—
 - (a) at the point of production, £31 per ton;
 - (b) at places other than the point of production, £31 per ton, plus properly incurred cost of transport from the point of production to the place of sale.
- (2) In respect of certified seed potatoes—
 - (a) at the point of production, £34 per ton;
 - (b) at places other than the point of production, £34 per ton, plus properly incurred cost of transport from the point of production to the place of sale.
- (3) In respect of seed potatoes other than approved or certified seed potatoes—
 - (a) at the point of production, £29 per ton;
 - (b) at places other than the point of production, £29 per ton, plus properly incurred cost of transport from the point of production to the place of sale.

6. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I fix and declare the maximum price at which seed potatoes may be sold by wholesale to be as follows:—

- (1) By primary wholesaler, Cowper-street—
 - (a) In respect of approved seed potatoes, the sum of the following:—
 - (i) The purchase price paid or payable or an amount calculated at the rate of £31 per ton, whichever is the lesser;
 - (ii) cost of rail transport from the railway station or siding nearest the seller's premises or place of business to Cowper-street railway siding.

(b) In respect of certified seed potatoes, the sum of the following:—

- (i) The purchase price paid or payable or an amount calculated at the rate of £34 per ton, whichever is the lesser;
- (ii) cost of rail transport from the railway station or siding nearest the seller's premises or place of business to Cowper-street railway siding.

(c) In respect of seed potatoes other than approved or certified seed potatoes, the sum of the following:—

- (i) The purchase price paid or payable or an amount calculated at the rate of £29 per ton, whichever is the lesser;
- (ii) cost of rail transport from the railway station or siding nearest the seller's premises or place of business to Cowper-street railway siding.

(2) By secondary wholesaler—

(a) In respect of approved seed potatoes—

- (i) where the seller delivers the approved seed potatoes to the purchaser at the seller's store, £33 per ton;
- (ii) where the seller delivers the approved seed potatoes into the buyer's shop, £33 12s. 6d. per ton.

(b) In respect of certified seed potatoes—

- (i) where the seller delivers the certified seed potatoes to the purchaser at the seller's store, £36 per ton;
- (ii) where the seller delivers the certified seed potatoes into the buyer's shop, £36 12s. 6d. per ton.

(c) In respect of seed potatoes other than approved or certified seed potatoes—

- (i) where the seller delivers the seed potatoes to the purchaser at the seller's store, £31 per ton;
- (ii) where the seller delivers the seed potatoes into the buyer's shop, £31 12s. 6d. per ton.

Sales by Retail.

7. (1) I fix and declare the maximum price at which seed potatoes may be sold by retail in the Metropolitan Area to be—

- (a) in respect of approved seed potatoes—5d. per lb.
- (b) in respect of certified seed potatoes—5½d. per lb.
- (c) in respect of seed potatoes—4½d. per lb.

(2) I fix and declare the maximum price at which seed potatoes may be sold by retail outside the Metropolitan Area to be the prices fixed in the foregoing provisions of this Order for such sales in the Metropolitan Area, plus the charges properly incurred in transporting such seed potatoes from the point of delivery to the retailer to such retailer's shop or place of business, but in no case shall such maximum price exceed—

- (a) in respect of approved seed potatoes—5½d. per lb.
- (b) in respect of certified seed potatoes—6d. per lb.
- (c) in respect of seed potatoes—5d. per lb.

Exhibition of Price Tickets.

8. (1) Any person who sells or has for sale by retail seed potatoes shall attach to or display with those seed potatoes a ticket or label setting forth the maximum retail selling price fixed by or under the provisions of this Order for the sale by him of those seed potatoes.

(2) Any ticket or label required by sub-clause (1) of this clause to be attached to or displayed with any seed potatoes shall be in such a form as to be easily legible to any person inspecting or viewing those seed potatoes and so as to be properly associated with such seed potatoes.

Delivery of Invoices.

9. Any person who sells by wholesale seed potatoes shall deliver with such seed potatoes an invoice or docket containing the following particulars:—

- (a) Name and address of seller;
- (b) name and address of purchaser;
- (c) date of sale;
- (d) the point of delivery to the purchaser, the weight of the seed potatoes sold, number of bags, and price per unit of such seed potatoes; and
- (e) total price of such seed potatoes.

Records.

10. Any person who sells any seed potatoes shall keep and preserve any invoice or docket received by him in relation to such seed potatoes, and shall keep a record in respect of the purchase of such seed potatoes showing—

- (a) the name and address of supplier;
- (b) the date of the invoice or docket received by him in relation to such seed potatoes;
- (c) the quantity purchased and the price thereof;
- (d) the point of delivery; and
- (e) transport costs properly attributable to the transport of such seed potatoes from the point of delivery to his place of business.

Fixation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

11. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any seed potatoes specified in a notice given in pursuance of this clause may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.
