### PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the second year of the reign of Her present Majesty Queen Elizabeth II., intituled the Entertainments Tax (Amendment) Act 1953, it is amongst other things enacted that the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette: Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation fix Monday the twenty-first day of December, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-three as the date upon which the said Entertainments Tax (Amendment) Act 1953 shall come into operation in the said State of Victoria.
