BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE DETERMINATION OF A WAGES FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

MALES.

One male apprentice to every three or fraction of three male workers receiving not less than 246s. per week of 40 hours.

PEMALES.

One female apprentice to every three or fraction of three female workers receiving not less than 191s. 3d. per week of 40 hours.

Improvers.

MALES.

Two male improvers to every male worker receiving not less than 246s, per week of 40 hours.

FEMALES.

Four female improvers to every female worker receiving not less than 191s. 3d. per week of 40 hours.
