PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 523.

BOVINE HIDES AND SKINS.

I N pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

*Citation.*

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 523.

*Revocation.*

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 223 as amended by Prices Regulation Order No. 418 is hereby revoked.

*Application.*

3. This Order shall apply to bovine hides and skins produced in Victoria or Tasmania.

*Definition and Interpretations.*

4. (1) "Meatworks" means an establishment at which stock is slaughtered and treated principally for export.

(2) The grades, classifications, terms, and descriptions appearing in the Schedule to this Order are those customarily used by persons trading in bovine hides and skins.

(3) Wherever the words and figures "Tare 4 per cent." appear in the Schedule to this Order in relation to any hides or skins, before calculating in respect of any such hides or skins the maximum permissible selling price fixed in relation thereto under this Order, the total weight of the lot of hides or skins the subject of the sale shall be reduced by 4 per cent.

*Maximum Prices.*

5. I fix and declare the maximum price in pence per pound at which any grade, class, type or weight of bovine hide or skin or lot thereof specified in the Schedule to this Order may be sold or offered for sale by any person to be the price in pence per pound specified therein.

*Delivery of Invoices.*

6. Any person who sells any bovine hides or skins of a grade, class, type or weight specified in the Schedule to this Order shall deliver with such bovine hides or skins an invoice or docket in relation thereto containing the following particulars:—

- (i) name and address of the seller;
- (ii) name and address of the purchaser;
- (iii) date of sale;
- (iv) lot number or sale list number;
- (v) description, in terms of the relevant description in the Schedule to this Order, of the grade, class, type or weight of the bovine hides or skins sold;
- (vi) price per pound of the hides or skins sold;
- (vii) total weight of the hides or skins sold;
- (viii) total price of the hides or skins sold;
- (ix) terms and conditions of sale;

and shall keep and preserve a duplicate or copy of such invoice or docket.

*Exhibition of Price List.*

7. Every person who sells or has for sale any bovine hides or skins shall exhibit in a prominent position in his place of business or, if he has more than one place of business, in each of his places of business, a notice or notices setting forth his maximum selling price per pound in relation to each grade, class, type or weight of bovine hides or skins, that is to say by exhibiting a copy of the Schedule to this Order.

*Price Tickets.*

8. Every person who sells or has for sale any bovine hides or skins shall exhibit in relation to each lot of such hides or skins displayed by him anywhere upon his place or places of business a separate price card—

- (i) describing such lot in terms of the relevant description or descriptions in the Schedule to this Order for that grade, class, type or weight of hides or skins comprised in such lot; and
- (ii) specifying the maximum selling in pence per pound of such lot, so as to properly associate such description and such price per pound with the bovine hides or skins to which that description and that price apply.

*Auction Sales of Bovine Hides or Skins.*

9. I hereby permit a sale by auction of any bovine hides or skins only insofar as the terms and conditions appearing in paragraphs 9 to 12 inclusive of this Order are complied with.

*Catalogue.*

10. (i) Any person who proposes to conduct any auction sale of any bovine hides or skins shall, except insofar as the exemption is granted by Notice in Writing by the Prices Commissioner to that person, prepare and deliver to the Prices Commissioner a complete catalogue of the bovine hides and skins to be offered for sale at such auction.

(ii) The catalogue referred to shall be delivered to the Prices Commissioner not less than 24 hours prior to the time of the auction.

(iii) Subject to the provisions of sub-paragraph (i) hereof such catalogue shall describe the bovine hides and skins to be offered at such auction in terms of the relevant description of the grade, class, type or weight in the Schedule to this Order applicable to those hides or skins and specify any identifying number to be used for the purpose of such auction and a proposed selling price per pound not exceeding the maximum selling price per pound in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 4 of this Order.

*Records.*

11. All persons who sell any bovine hides or skins by auction or otherwise shall keep a complete record of—

- (a) the names and addresses of the owner or owners of those bovine hides or skins;
- (b) the names and addresses of the purchasers of those bovine hides or skins;
- (c) the prices per pound at which those bovine hides or skins were sold—

and shall preserve that record until its destruction is authorized by the Prices Commissioner.

*Bidding.*

12. No bid of a price in excess of the maximum fixed in accordance with this Order shall be acknowledged by the auctioneer.

*Announcement.*

13. Immediately prior to the commencement of any auction the auctioneer, in addition to any other announcement which he is required by law to make, shall announce that no bid will be accepted of prices in excess of the maximum price fixed in accordance with this Order.

*Fixation of Maximum Prices by Notice.*

14. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which bovine hides and skins specified in a notice in pursuance of this paragraph may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Prices Commissioner by Notice in Writing to that person.

## PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 524.

## BOVINE HIDES AND SKINS.

I N pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

*Citation.*

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 524.

*Revocation.*

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 224 as amended by Prices Regulation Order No. 419 is hereby revoked.

*Application.*

3. This Order shall apply only to bovine hides and skins produced in States other than Victoria or Tasmania.

*Definition and Interpretations.*

4. In this Order unless the contrary intention appears—

“meatworks” means an establishment at which stock is slaughtered and treated principally for export;

the grades, classifications, terms, and descriptions appearing in this Order are those customarily used by persons trading in bovine hides and skins;

wherever the word and figures “Tare 4 per cent.” appear in this Order in relation to any hides or skins, before calculating in respect of any such hides or skins the maximum permissible selling price fixed in relation thereto under this Order, the total weight of the hides or skins sold shall be reduced by 4 per cent.

*Maximum Prices.*

5. I fix and declare the maximum price in pence per pound at which any grade, class, type or weight of bovine hides or skins or lot thereof specified in the Schedules to this Order may be sold or offered for sale by any person to be—

- (a) in respect of bovine hides and skins produced in New South Wales the price in pence per pound specified in the First Schedule to this Order;
- (b) in respect of bovine hides and skins produced in South Australia the price in pence per pound specified in the Second Schedule to this Order;
- (c) in respect of bovine hides and skins produced in Queensland the price in pence per pound specified in the Third Schedule to this Order;
- (d) in respect of bovine hides and skins produced in Western Australia the price in pence per pound specified in the Fourth Schedule to this Order.

*Delivery of Invoices.*

6. Any person who sells any bovine hides or skins of a grade, class, type or weight specified in the Schedules to this Order shall deliver with such bovine hides or skins an invoice or docket in relation thereto containing the following particulars:—

- (i) name and address of the seller;
- (ii) name and address of the purchaser;
- (iii) date of sale;
- (iv) lot number or sale list number;
- (v) description, in the terms of the relevant description in the Schedules to this Order, of the grade, class, type, or weight of the bovine hides or skins sold;
- (vi) price per pound;
- (vii) total weight;
- (viii) total price;
- (ix) terms and conditions of sale;

and shall keep and preserve a duplicate or copy of such invoice or docket.

*Exhibition of Price List.*

7. Every person who sells or has for sale any bovine hides or skins shall exhibit in a prominent position in his place of business or, if he has more than one place of business, in each of his places of business, a notice or notices setting forth his maximum selling price per pound in relation to each grade, class, type or weight of bovine hides or skins, that is to say by exhibiting a copy of the Schedule to this Order.

## Prices Regulation Acts.

## PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 529.

## MILK—VICTORIA—COUNTRY AREAS.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

*Citation.*

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 529.

*Revocation.*

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 469 is hereby revoked.

*Definitions and Interpretation.*

3. (1) In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—
  - “By retail” or “by wholesale” means, in relation to any sale of milk, that such sale is a sale by retail or by wholesale, as the case may be, but is not a sale by semi-wholesale.
  - “By semi-wholesale” means, in relation to the sale of any milk—
    - (a) that such milk is sold by a retailer to a person to whom the retailer has, on the day of the sale, sold a quantity of milk (including that comprised in such first-mentioned sale) exceeding 2 gallons; or
    - (b) is a sale to a person who conducts a shop where milk is sold separately from any milk round.
  - “Central Area” means the area specified in Part I. of the Second Schedule to this Order.
  - “Gippsland Area” means the area specified in Part II. of the Second Schedule to this Order.
  - “Mallee Area” means the area specified in Part III. of the Second Schedule to this Order.
  - “Melbourne Milk Board Area” means the area which at the date of this Order constituted the Metropolis as defined for the purposes of the Milk Board Acts.
  - “North-Central Area” means the area specified in Part IV. of the Second Schedule to this Order.
  - “North-Eastern Area” means the area specified in Part V. of the Second Schedule to this Order.
  - “Northern Area” means the area specified in Part VI. of the Second Schedule to this Order.
  - “Treatment” includes the pasteurization, cooling, chilling, refrigerating of milk, and “treated” has a corresponding meaning.
  - “Western Area” means the area specified in Part VII. of the Second Schedule to this Order.
  - “Wimmera Area” means the area specified in Part VIII. of the Second Schedule to this Order.

(2) For the purpose of this Order, where any post office or principal post office of any place is situated within any Area to which this Order applies but less than 3 miles from any boundary line thereof, then all places within 3 miles of that post office, or principal post office, as the case may be, shall be deemed to be within the area in which that post office, or principal post office, is situated.

*Maximum Prices—Specified Areas.*

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which milk may be sold for delivery in any of the areas specified in the first column of the First Schedule to this Order to be—

- (a) in respect of sales to retailers (excluding semi-wholesale sales)—
  - (i) where delivery is taken at the retailer's premises—the price specified in the second column of that Schedule opposite to such area; or
  - (ii) where delivery is taken at any other place—the price specified in sub-paragraph (i) of this paragraph less the cost which would be incurred in transporting the milk to the retailer's premises;

(b) in respect of sales by retail—

- (i) the price specified in the fourth column of that Schedule opposite such area; or
- (ii) the price paid or payable by the retail seller for such milk plus any cost incurred in transporting that milk to his premises, plus an amount computed at the rate of—

For bulk milk—2s. 3½d. per gallon;

For milk in sealed bottles—2s. 7½d. per gallon;

Whichever price is the lesser.

Provided that the maximum price for milk supplied to persons having milk delivered to them regularly in retail quantities of one quart or more per day shall be computed on a weekly basis by multiplying the total quartage delivered during such week by the maximum price per quart fixed by the foregoing provisions of this paragraph.

(c) in respect of sales by semi-wholesale—

- (i) the price specified in the third column of that Schedule opposite such area; or
- (ii) the price paid or payable for such milk by the semi-wholesaler, plus an amount computed at the rate of—

For bulk milk—1s. 3½d. per gallon;

For milk in sealed bottles—Pints—1s. 8½d. per gallon;

For milk in sealed bottles—Half Pints—1s. 11½d. per gallon;

Whichever price is the lesser.

*Maximum Prices—Treatment Depots.*

5. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I fix and declare the maximum price at which milk may be sold to any person (other than a retailer) for treatment in any area specified in the Schedules to this Order to be the maximum price for the sale of that milk to a retailer in that area.

6. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I fix and declare the maximum price at which milk may be sold to a retailer by any person who has purchased that milk and treated that milk in any area specified in the Schedules to this Order to be the maximum price fixed for the sale of that milk to a retailer in that area, plus an amount computed at the rate of 3d. per gallon.

*Fixation of Maximum Prices by Notice.*

7. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I fix and declare the maximum price at which milk may be sold in any area specified in the Schedules to this Order by any person to whom a notice is given in pursuance of this clause to be the price fixed by the Prices Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

## PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 530.

## MILK—GEELONG AREA.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

*Citation.*

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 530.

*Revocation.*

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 470 is hereby revoked.

*Definitions.*

3. (1) In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears:—  
 “By retail” or “by wholesale” means, in relation to any sale of milk in the Geelong area, that such sale is a sale by retail or by wholesale as the case may be, but is not a sale by semi-wholesale.  
 “By semi-wholesale” means, in relation to the sale of any milk in the Geelong area—  
 (a) that such milk is sold by a retailer to a person, to whom the retailer has, on the day of the sale, sold a quantity of milk (including that comprised in such first mentioned sale) exceeding 2 gallons; or  
 (b) is a sale to a person who conducts a shop where milk is sold separately from any milk round.  
 “Geelong area” means all that area of Victoria comprised in the Boroughs of Geelong, Geelong West, Newtown and Chilwell, and Queenscliff, and the Shires of Barrabool, Bellarine, Corio, and South Barwon.  
 “Treatment” includes the pasteurization, cooling, chilling, refrigerating of milk, and “treated” has a corresponding meaning.  
 (2) For the purpose of this Order, where any post office, or principal post office of any place, is situated within the Geelong Area but less than 3 miles from any boundary line thereof, then all places within 3 miles of that post office or principal post office, as the case may be, shall be deemed to be within the Geelong area.

*Maximum Prices—Geelong Area.*

4. I fix and declare the maximum prices at which milk may be sold for delivery in the Geelong Area, including any cost of delivery to the purchaser, to be—

- (a) in respect of sales by wholesale—3s. 6½d. per gallon;
- (b) in respect of sales by semi-wholesale—  
 (1) loose—5s. 2½d. per gallon,  
 (2) in bottles—5s. 6½d. per gallon;

(c) in respect of sales by retail—

Per half pint ..	0 5	0 5½
Per pint ..	0 9½	0 10
Per quart ..	1 5½	1 6½

Provided that the maximum price for milk supplied to persons having milk delivered to them regularly in retail quantities of 1 quart or more per day shall be computed on a weekly basis by multiplying the total quartage delivered during such week by the maximum price per quart fixed by this sub-paragraph.

*Maximum Prices—Treatment Depots.*

5. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I fix and declare the maximum price at which milk may be sold to any person (other than a retailer) for treatment in the Geelong area to be the maximum price for the sale of that milk by wholesale in that area.

6. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I fix and declare the maximum price at which milk may be sold by wholesale by any person who has purchased that milk and treated that milk in the Geelong area to be the maximum price fixed for the sale of that milk by wholesale in that area plus an amount computed at the rate of 3d. per gallon.

*Fixation of Maximum Price by Notice.*

7. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I fix and declare the maximum price at which milk may be sold in the Geelong area by any person to whom a notice in pursuance of this clause is given to be the price fixed by the Prices Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 531.

CANNED FRUIT—SALES OTHER THAN BY RETAIL.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

*Citation.*

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 531.

*Revocation.*

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 437 is hereby revoked.

*Definitions.*

3. In this Order unless the contrary intention appears—
  - "Metropolitan Area" means all that area comprised within a radius of 25 miles from the General Post Office, Melbourne;
  - "12 oz. tin" means any tin holding 12 ounces or more but less than 16 ounces;
  - "16 oz. tin" means any tin holding 16 ounces or more but less than 20 ounces;
  - "20 oz. tin" means any tin holding 20 ounces or more but less than 30 ounces;
  - "30 oz. tin" means any tin holding 30 ounces or more but less than 4 pounds;
  - "4 lb. tin" means any tin holding 4 pounds or more but less than 6½ pounds;
  - "6½ lb. tin" means any tin holding 6½ pounds or more but less than 7 pounds;
  - "7 lb. tin" means any tin holding 7 pounds or more.

*Maximum Prices.*

4. I fix and declare the maximum prices at which canned fruits of any of the descriptions specified in the Schedule to this Order may be sold to wholesalers or to retailers to be the prices specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Provided that in respect of all sales where payment by the purchaser is made within seven days of the receipt of the invoice, a discount of 5 per cent. shall be allowed from the maximum prices specified in the Schedule to this Order.

*Delivery of Invoice.*

5. Any person who sells any canned fruits of any of the descriptions specified in the Schedule to this Order shall deliver with such canned fruit an invoice or docket containing the following particulars:—

- (i) Name and address of the seller;
- (ii) Name and address of the purchaser;
- (iii) Date of sale;
- (iv) The quantity and description of the canned fruit contained in the sale;
- (v) Price per unit charged;
- (vi) Total price charged; and
- (vii) That if payment is made within seven days, a discount of 5 per cent. is allowable.

6. Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which canned fruit, a maximum price for the sale of which is fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order and which is specified in a notice given in pursuance of this clause, may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given, to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.
