PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 555.

AERATED WATERS, AERATED FRUIT DRINKS, MINERAL WATERS—SALES BY
THE BOTTLE—RETAIL—NORTH-EASTERN AREA.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Commissioner for the State of Victoria, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 555.

Revocation.

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 486 is hereby revoked.

Non-Application of Prior Order.

3. Nothing contained in Prices Regulation Order No. 217, insofar as it relates to Sales by Retail, shall apply to any goods, the maximum prices of which are fixed by or under this Order.

Definitions.

4. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—
“North-Eastern Area” means all that area of Victoria comprised in—

the Boroughs of—

“Town of manufacture” means—

- (a) where the manufacture is named in the first column of the First, Second, or Third Schedules hereto—the town or city specified in the second column of the said Schedules;

(b) where the manufacturer is not named in the First, Second, or Third Schedules hereto—

- (i) if the goods are produced in Victoria, the actual town of manufacture,
- (ii) if the goods are produced outside Victoria, the town or city in Victoria nearest to the place of manufacture.

For the purposes of this Order, Wodonga shall be deemed to be the town in Victoria nearest to Albury, New South Wales, and Wahgunyah as the town in Victoria nearest to Corowa, New South Wales.

"Oz." means fluid ounce or ounces, as the case may be, and one fluid ounce shall be equivalent to one-twentieth of a pint.

"Quarts" means bottles (excluding syphons) containing 24 fluid ounces or over.

"Pints" means bottles containing 10 oz. or over, but less than 24 oz.

"Splits" means bottles containing 6 oz. or over, but less than 10 oz.

*Bottled Aerated Waters, Aerated Fruit Drinks, and Mineral Waters—
Sales by the Bottle.*

5. I fix and declare the maximum price at which bottled aerated water, aerated fruit drinks, and mineral waters of the description set out in the third column of the First Schedule to this Order and manufactured by the persons set out in the first column of such Schedule may be sold in the North-Eastern Area to be—
the price set out in the fourth column of such Schedule.

6. I fix and declare the maximum price at which bottled aerated waters, aerated fruit drinks, and mineral waters of the description set out in the third column of the Second Schedule to this Order and manufactured by the persons set out in the first column of such Schedule may be sold in the North-Eastern Area to be—

- (a) in all that area comprised within a radius of 10 miles from the principal post office of the town of manufacture, the price set out in the fourth column of such Schedule;
- (b) in all that area comprised within a radius of 30 miles from the principal post office of the town of manufacture, but outside a radius of 10 miles of the said post office, the price set out in the fifth column of such Schedule; and
- (c) in all that area comprised within a radius of 50 miles from the principal post office of the town of manufacture, but outside a radius of 30 miles from the said post office, the price set out in the sixth column of such Schedule;
- (d) in all areas outside a radius of 50 miles from the principal post office of the town of manufacture, the price set out in the seventh column of such Schedule.

7. I fix and declare the maximum price at which bottled aerated waters, aerated fruit drinks, and mineral waters of the description set out in the third column of the Third Schedule to this Order and manufactured by the persons set out in the first column of such Schedule may be sold in the North-Eastern Area to be—

- (a) in all that area comprised within a radius of 15 miles from the principal post office of the town of manufacture, the price set out in the fourth column of such Schedule;
- (b) in all that area comprised within a radius of 30 miles from the principal post office of the town of manufacture, but outside a radius of 15 miles of the said post office, the price set out in the fifth column of such Schedule; and
- (c) in all that area comprised within a radius of 50 miles from the principal post office of the town of manufacture, but outside a radius of 30 miles from the said post office, the price set out in the sixth column of such Schedule;
- (d) in all areas outside a radius of 50 miles from the principal post office of the town of manufacture, the price set out in the seventh column of such Schedule.

Sales in Areas other than the North-Eastern Area.

8. I fix and declare the maximum price at which bottled aerated waters, aerated fruit drinks, table waters, and mineral waters of the descriptions set out in the third column of the First, Second, and Third Schedules to this Order and manufactured by the persons specified in the first column of the said Schedules may be sold by retail in any area in Victoria not in the North-Eastern Area to be—

- (a) When manufactured by any of the persons specified in the first column of the First Schedule—
the price set out in the fourth column of that Schedule;
and
- (b) when manufactured by any of the persons specified in the first column of the Second and Third Schedules—
the price set out in the seventh column of such Schedules.

9. I fix and declare the maximum prices at which bottled aerated waters, aerated fruit drinks, table waters, and mineral waters manufactured by Schweppes Ltd., of Abbotsford, Melbourne, and Rowlands Pty. Ltd., of Melbourne and Ballarat, may be sold in the North-Eastern Area to be the sum of—

- (i) the price paid or payable for such aerated waters or drinks;
- (ii) fifty per centum of such price;
- (iii) the cost to the vendor of rail freight actually incurred in transporting the goods from Melbourne or Ballarat as the case may be to the railway station nearest to the vendor's premises—such sum to be computed to the nearest upward half-penny.

10. Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing provisions of this Order—

where at the request of the purchaser a bottle containing not more than 13 oz. is opened for the purpose of consumption on the premises of the vendor, and a straw or glass is provided by the vendor, to the price applicable thereto in accordance with the Schedules to this Order, there may be added one half-penny.

Refund of Deposits on Bottles.

11. Where any sum lodged as a deposit on a bottle or bottles or other containers of any goods, the maximum price of which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, is accepted by the vendor of such goods, the vendor shall, upon the return of such bottle or bottles or other containers in respect of which such deposit was lodged, refund such deposit in full to the person who lodged such deposit.

Variation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

12. Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any aerated waters, aerated fruit drinks, mineral waters, specified in a notice given in pursuance of this clause may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

Exhibition of Price List.

13. Every person who sells or has for sale by retail any goods, the maximum price of which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, shall exhibit and keep exhibited in a prominent position in his place of business, or if he has more than one place of business in each of his places of business, in the form of a price list and in such a manner as to be easily legible to persons contemplating making any purchase or conducting any business at his place or places of business, particulars of the maximum prices fixed by or under the provisions of this Order for the sale by him of those goods, such notice to show separately the deposit charge (if any) for any container included in the selling price so exhibited.

RETAIL SALES—GIPPSLAND AREA.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 556.

Revocation.

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 425 is hereby revoked.

Application.

3. (a) This Order shall not apply to sales (not being sales by the bottle) made by a licensed victualler.

(b) Nothing contained in Prices Regulation Order No. 217, insofar as it relates to sales by retail, shall apply to any goods the maximum prices of which are fixed under this Order.

Definitions.

4. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—
“Gippsland Area” means all that area of Victoria comprised in the Town of Sale, the Borough of Wonthaggi, and the Shires of—

I fix and declare the maximum price at which bottled aerated waters, mineral waters, table waters, and fruit drinks of the description set out in the third column of the Schedule to this Order and manufactured by the persons set out in the first column of such Schedule may be sold by retail in the Gippsland Area to be the prices specified in the fourth column of such Schedule.

6. I fix and declare the maximum retail prices at which bottled aerated waters, aerated fruit drinks, table waters, and mineral waters manufactured by Schweppes Ltd., Abbotsford, Melbourne, and Rowlands Pty. Ltd., Melbourne, may be sold in the Gippsland Area to be the sum of—

- (i) the price paid or payable for such aerated waters or drinks;
- (ii) fifty per centum of such price;
- (iii) the cost to the vendor of rail freight actually incurred in transporting the goods from Melbourne to the railway station nearest to the vendor's premises—such sum to be computed to the nearest upward half-penny.

7. Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing provisions of this Order, where at the request of the purchaser a bottle of capacity not exceeding 13 oz. is opened for the purpose of consumption on the premises of the vendor thereof, and a glass or straw is provided by the vendor, to the price applicable thereto in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Order there may be added one half-penny.

Refund of Deposits on Bottles.

8. Where any sum lodged as a deposit on a bottle or bottles or other containers of any goods, the maximum price of which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, is accepted by the vendor of such goods, the vendor shall, upon the return of such bottle or bottles or other containers in respect of which such deposit was lodged, refund such deposit in full to the person who lodged such deposit.

Variation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

9. Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any aerated waters, mineral waters, table waters, or fruit drinks specified in a notice given in pursuance of this clause may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

Exhibition of Price List.

10. Every person who sells or has for sale by retail any goods, the maximum price of which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, shall exhibit and keep exhibited in a prominent position in his place of business, or if he has more than one place of business, in each of his places of business, in the form of a price list and in such a manner as to be easily legible to persons contemplating making any purchase or conducting any business, at his place or places of business, particulars of the maximum prices fixed by or under the provisions of this Order for the sale by him of those goods, such notice to show separately the deposit charge (if any) for any container included in the selling price so exhibited.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 557.

RICE—POLISHED—SALES BY PROCESSOR OR WHOLESALER.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 557.

Revocation.

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 434 is hereby revoked.

Definitions.

3. In this Order, unless the contrary appears—
“Metropolitan area” means all that area comprised within a radius of 20 miles from the General Post Office, Melbourne.

Maximum Price—Sales by Processor.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which polished rice may be sold by a processor to be £90 per ton of 2,240 lb.

Maximum Price—Sales by Wholesale in Metropolitan Area.

5. I fix and declare the maximum price at which polished rice may be sold by wholesale by a person other than a processor for delivery in the metropolitan area to be £96 per ton of 2,240 lb.

Maximum Price—Sales by Wholesale Outside Metropolitan Area.

6. I fix and declare the maximum price at which polished rice may be sold by wholesale by a person other than a processor for delivery outside the metropolitan area to be £96 per ton of 2,240 lb., plus the actual amount of freight (if any) paid or payable by the wholesaler in respect of the transport of that polished rice to the point of delivery to the purchaser.

Discounts.

7. (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Order, where a processor or wholesaler of polished rice has customarily allowed, in relation to sales, any difference in price—

- (a) to any person or to any person included in any class of persons;
- (b) in respect of sales of certain quantities of such goods; or
- (c) in respect of sales under Special Conditions of Sale; or upon certain terms of payment—

the maximum prices fixed by or under this Order in respect of those goods shall, in the case of sales to any such person or persons, or in such quantities, or under such conditions, or upon such terms of payment, be reduced by the allowance of such difference.

- (2) In every case, whether any such difference in price has been customarily allowed or not, where payment for polished rice is made within seven days from date of delivery, a deduction shall be made, and shall not be less than 3 per centum of the purchase price, or where payment for such goods is made within 30 days from date of delivery, the deduction shall not be less than 2½ per centum of the purchase price.

Fixation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

8. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum prices at which polished rice specified in a notice given in pursuance of this clause may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

SEED POTATOES.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Commissioner for the State of Victoria, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 559.

Revocation.

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 534 is hereby revoked.

Definitions.

3. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—
 - “Certified seed potatoes” means potatoes accepted by a duly authorized officer of the State Department of Agriculture as certified seed potatoes.
 - “Primary wholesaler” in relation to the sale of seed potatoes means a person who purchases seed potatoes for the purpose of resale to another wholesaler whose normal business is to sell seed potatoes by wholesale.
 - “Secondary wholesaler” in relation to the sale of seed potatoes means a person who purchases seed potatoes from a primary wholesaler for the purpose of resale.
 - “By wholesale” means and refers to a sale of seed potatoes in lots of one bag or more.
 - “Ton” means a long ton of 2,240 lb. or a quantity of fifteen bags of seed potatoes each containing not less than 149 lb. weight.
 - “Lb.” means pound avoirdupois or pounds avoirdupois as the case requires.
 - “Metropolitan area” means all that area comprised within a radius of 20 miles from the General Post Office, Melbourne.
 - “Point of delivery” means, in relation to the sale of seed potatoes, the place at which liability for payment of transport charges in conveying such seed potatoes to his place of business passed to the seller from the person from whom he purchased them.
 - “Cost of transport” means, in relation to the transport of seed potatoes, cost of transport by rail (or, if rail transport is not available, any other service which may be available), but does not include any cost of transport which is not recorded on an invoice delivered by the seller, or in the case of sales by retail, or an invoice delivered to the retail seller.
 - “Potato marketing board” means the potato marketing board constituted under the *Marketing of Primary Products Act 1935* of the State of Victoria.

Sales by Growers.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which seed potatoes may be sold by growers to be—

- (1) in respect of certified seed potatoes—
 - (a) at the point of production, £41 10s. per ton;
 - (b) at places other than the point of production, £41 10s. per ton, plus properly incurred cost of transport from the point of production to the place of sale;
- (2) in respect of seed potatoes other than certified seed potatoes—
 - (a) at the point of production, £37 10s. per ton;
 - (b) at places other than the point of production, £37 10s. per ton, plus properly incurred cost of transport from the point of production to the place of sale.

Sales by the Potato Marketing Board.

5. I fix and declare the maximum price at which seed potatoes may be sold by the Potato Marketing Board to be—

- (1) in respect of certified seed potatoes—
 - (a) at the point of production, £42 10s. per ton;
 - (b) at places other than the point of production, £42 10s. per ton, plus properly incurred cost of transport from the point of production to the place of sale;

(2) in respect of seed potatoes other than certified seed potatoes—

- (a) at the point of production, £37 10s. per ton;
- (b) at places other than the point of production, £37 10s. per ton, plus properly incurred cost of transport from the point of production to the place of sale.

6. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I fix and declare the maximum price at which seed potatoes may be sold by wholesale to be as follows:—

(1) By primary wholesaler—

- (a) in respect of certified seed potatoes—
 - (i) at the point of production, £42 10s. per ton;
 - (ii) at places other than the point of production, £42 10s. per ton, plus properly incurred cost of transport from the point of production to the place of sale.
- (b) in respect of seed potatoes other than certified seed potatoes—
 - (i) at the point of production, £37 10s. per ton;
 - (ii) at places other than the point of production, £37 10s. per ton, plus properly incurred cost of transport from the point of production to the place of sale.

(2) By secondary wholesaler—

- (a) in respect of certified seed potatoes, the sum of the following:—
 - (i) The purchase price paid or payable or an amount calculated at the rate of £42 10s. per ton, whichever is the lesser;
 - (ii) cost of transporting such certified seed potatoes by rail from the railway station or siding nearest the seller's premises or place of business to the railway station or siding nearest the purchaser's premises or place of business;
 - (iii) a margin—
 - (A) where the seller delivers the certified seed potatoes to the purchaser at the seller's store or at the railway station or siding nearest the seller's premises or place of business, of £1 7s. 6d. per ton; or
 - (B) where the seller delivers the certified seed potatoes into the buyer's shop, of £2 per ton.
- (b) In respect to seed potatoes other than certified seed potatoes the sum of the following:—
 - (i) The purchase price paid or payable or an amount calculated at the rate of £37 10s. per ton, whichever is the lesser;
 - (ii) cost of transporting such seed potatoes by rail from the railway station or siding nearest the seller's premises or place of business to the railway station or siding nearest the purchaser's premises or place of business;
 - (iii) a margin—
 - (A) where the seller delivers the seed potatoes to the purchaser at the seller's store or at the railway station or siding nearest the seller's premises or place of business, of £1 7s. 6d. per ton; or
 - (B) where the seller delivers the seed potatoes into the buyer's shop, of £2 per ton.

Sales by Retail.

7. (1) I fix and declare the maximum price at which seed potatoes may be sold by retail in the metropolitan area to be—

- (a) in respect of certified seed potatoes, 11½d. per 2 lb.;
- (b) in respect of seed potatoes, 10½d. per 2 lb.

(2) I fix and declare the maximum price at which seed potatoes may be sold by retail outside the metropolitan area to be the prices fixed in the foregoing provisions of this Order for such sales in the metropolitan area, plus the charges properly incurred in transporting such seed potatoes from the point of delivery to the retailer to such retailer's shop or place of business but in no case shall such maximum price exceed—

- (a) in respect of certified seed potatoes, 6d. per lb.;
- (b) in respect of seed potatoes, 5½d. per lb.

Exhibition of Price Tickets.

8. (1) Any person who sells or has for sale by retail seed potatoes shall attach to or display with those seed potatoes a ticket or label setting forth the maximum retail selling price fixed by or under the provisions of this Order for the sale by him of those seed potatoes.

(2) Any ticket or label required by sub-clause (1) of this clause to be attached to or displayed with any seed potatoes shall be in such a form as to be easily legible to any person inspecting or viewing those seed potatoes and so as to be properly associated with such seed potatoes.

Delivery of Invoices.

9. Any person who sells by wholesale seed potatoes shall deliver with such seed potatoes an invoice or docket containing the following particulars:—

- (a) Name and address of seller;
- (b) name and address of purchaser;
- (c) date of sale;
- (d) the point of delivery to the purchaser, the weight of the seed potatoes sold, number of bags, and price per unit of such seed potatoes; and
- (e) total price of such seed potatoes.

Records.

10. Any person who sells any seed potatoes shall keep and preserve any invoice or docket received by him in relation to such seed potatoes, and shall keep a record in respect of the purchase of such seed potatoes showing—

- (a) the name and address of supplier;
- (b) the date of the invoice or docket received by him in relation to such seed potatoes;
- (c) the quantity purchased and the price thereof;
- (d) the point of delivery; and
- (e) transport costs properly attributable to the transport of such seed potatoes from the point of delivery to his place of business.

Fixation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

11. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any seed potatoes specified in a notice given in pursuance of this clause may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given, to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

DETERMINATION No. 43 OF THE POLICE CLASSIFICATION BOARD.

The Police Classification Board, in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred by the *Police Regulation Act 1946*, hereby makes the following Determination, that is to say:—

1. The Determination (No. 2) of the Police Classification Board of the 13th November, 1946, and published in the *Government Gazette* on the 22nd November, 1946, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:—

(a) In paragraph 1, under the heading "Officers" after the word "cap" by deleting the words "(for winter and evening wear)", and after the word "with" where first appearing insert the word "black."

(b) In paragraph 1, under the heading "Sub-Officers and Constables (Foot Police)", by deleting therefrom—
"1 cap (for winter and evening wear), navy-blue cloth, with stiff cloth peak, complete with waterproof cover, of the pattern illustrated in the said Second Schedule"
and inserting therefor—

"1 cap (for winter and evening wear), navy-blue cloth, with stiff black leather peak complete with black waterproof cover, black leather chin strap fastened at sides with white metal buttons line 26 size in diameter, with Crown and words 'Police Force Victoria' stamped thereon, of pattern illustrated in the said Second Schedule."

(c) In paragraph 1, under the heading "Sub-Officers and Constables (Mounted Police)" by deleting therefrom—

"1 cap (for winter and evening wear), navy-blue cloth, with stiff cloth peak, complete with waterproof cover, of the pattern prescribed herein for foot police"

and inserting therefor—

"1 cap (for winter and evening wear), navy-blue cloth, with stiff black leather peak complete with black waterproof cover, black leather chin strap fastened at sides with white metal buttons line 26 size in diameter, with Crown and words 'Police Force Victoria' stamped thereon, of pattern illustrated in the said Third Schedule."

(d) In paragraph 1, under the heading of "Mobile Traffic Police, Members of the Force Performing Motor Cycle or Motor Car Duty, Motor Testing Police, and such Others as are Authorized by the Chief Commissioner of Police" by deleting therefrom—

"1 cap, navy-blue cloth, stiff peak (cloth), complete with waterproof cover, of the pattern herein prescribed for foot police"

and inserting therefor—

"1 cap (for wear with breeches and leggings) black leather, stiff black leather peak, with black leather chin strap fastened at sides with white metal buttons line 26 size in diameter, with Crown and words 'Police Force Victoria' stamped thereon, of pattern illustrated in the said Fourth Schedule."

"1 cap (for wear with foot trousers), navy-blue cloth, with stiff black leather peak, complete with black waterproof cover, black leather chin strap fastened at sides with white metal buttons line 26 size in diameter, with Crown and words 'Police Force Victoria' stamped thereon, of pattern illustrated in the said Second Schedule."

(e) In paragraph 1, opposite the marginal note "Summer Uniform" after the word "shirt" where first appearing by deleting therefrom "(with two breast pockets)" and after the word "police" where last appearing by inserting "but members of the Force when actually performing motor cycle duty shall wear breeches, leggings and black leather cap as illustrated in the said Fourth Schedule."

(f) Under the heading, "First Schedule", by inserting after the word "overcoat" in item (1) the word "gloves."

(g) Under the heading, "Fourth Schedule", by deleting the sub-heading "Sub-Officers and Constables (Mobile Traffic Control Uniform)" and inserting therefor, "Sub-Officers and Constables (Mobile Traffic Section, Members of the Force Performing Motor Cycle or Motor Car Duty and Motor Testing Police Uniform)" and by deleting in item (4) where appearing the expression "as for mounted police"; and by transposing items (3) and (4).

(h) In the photographs appearing after such Determination by deleting photographs in—

(i) First Schedule Nos. 1 and 2 and inserting therefor respectively, photographs entitled "First Schedule Nos. 1 and 2" annexed hereto;

(ii) Second Schedule Nos. 1, 2 and 3 and inserting therefor respectively, photographs entitled "Second Schedule Nos. 1, 2 and 3" annexed hereto; and

(iii) Fourth Schedule No. 4 and inserting therefor, photographs entitled "Fourth Schedule Nos. 3 and 4" annexed hereto.
