DETERMINATION OF THE INDUSTRIAL APPEALS COURT.

IN THE INDUSTRIAL APPEALS COURT:

IN THE MATTER of the *Factories and Shops Act 1928-1941*,

AND

IN THE MATTER of a Determination made by the Shops Board No. 9 (Drapers and Men's Clothing) on the 18th day of February, 1953,

AND

IN THE MATTER of an Appeal against Clause 9 of the said Determination.

Friday, the 12th day of June, 1953.

Having heard the above-mentioned Appeal on the 4th day of May, 1953, and on this day this Court doth order and determine:—

- (1) That the Appeal be allowed;
- (2) That Clause 9 be amended to read:—

“All employees shall be allowed the following meal intervals with permission to leave the shop for the whole of such intervals:—

From Monday to Friday, one hour for lunch between noon and 3 p.m.”

AND

IN THE MATTER of a Determination made by the Watchmen's Board on the 3rd day of February, 1953.

AND

IN THE MATTER of an Appeal to the Industrial Appeals Court.

Before the Industrial Appeals Court (Judge Gamble, K. H. Boykett, Esq., and J. V. Stout, Esq.).

Friday, the 12th day of June, 1953.

Having heard the above-mentioned Appeal, on the 4th day of May, 1953, and on this day this Court doth order and determine:—

- (1) That the Appeal be allowed;
- (2) That Clause 13 (b) of the Determination of the Watchmen's Board, dated the 23rd day of April, 1951, and in force as from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in May, 1951, be amended by the addition of the following proviso:—

“ Provided always that this clause shall not apply to any employee whose normal working week is less than 35 hours.”
- (3) That this amendment come into force as from the first pay period to commence on or after the 12th day of June, 1953.
