DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

One apprentice to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than 272s, per week of 40 hours.

Improvers. One improver to every four workers receiving not less than 272s per week of 40 hours.

Wages per Week of 40 Hours. Under 16 years of age 16 and under 17 years of age 17 and under 18 years of age 18 and under 19 years of age 19 and under 20 years of age 87 98 106 116 128 20 and under 21 years of age

Females (see clause 4).

PROPORTION (BY ANY EMPLOYEE).

Apprentices.

One female apprentice to every three or fraction of three female adult workers receiving not less than the minimum wage.

Improvers.

Two female improvers to every female adult worker receiving not less than the minimum wage.
