REGULATIONS RELATING TO FOODS, DRUGS, SUBSTANCES,
AND METHODS OF ANALYSIS.

UNDER the powers conferred by the Health Acts and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, and on the recommendation of the Food Standards Committee, doth hereby make the Regulations following (that is to say) :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Amending Food and Drug Standards Regulations 1954 (No. 1), shall be read and construed as one with the Food and Drug Standards Regulations 1939 and any Regulations amending the same, and shall come into operation upon publication in the *Government Gazette*, except that Clause 4 shall come into operation on the 1st January, 1955.

2. Sub-regulation (3) (b) of Regulation 10 of the Food and Drug Standards Regulations 1939 is hereby amended by the insertion of the expression "Oil Orange SS" immediately below the expression "151 Orange II."

3. Regulation 26 of the Food and Drug Standards Regulations 1939 is hereby amended by—

- (a) deleting the words "manufactured meats and" from paragraph (a) of sub-regulation (10);
- (b) inserting after the words "sausage meat" in paragraph (a) of sub-regulation (12) the words "canned meats and canned meat products";
- (c) inserting the following heading and sub-regulation immediately after sub-regulation (18):—

"Meat Pie

(19) (a) Meat Pie is cooked meat with or without cereal condiments seasoning and water enclosed in a case of pastry.

(b) Meat Pie shall contain not less than twenty-five parts per centum of meat (when determined by the prescribed method). The meat so determined shall contain not more than thirty-three and one-third parts per centum of fat."

4. Immediately after Regulation 26 of the Food and Drug Standards Regulations 1939 the following regulation shall be inserted:—

"26A. CANNED MEATS AND CANNED MEAT PRODUCTS.

General.

(1) Canned Meats or Canned Meat Products are the products prepared, in accordance with the best commercial practice, from meat, or meat with other wholesome foodstuffs, with or without salt, sugar, saltpetre, seasoning, and water, packed into clean tinplate containers, hermetically sealed and processed by heat to ensure preservation. They shall contain not more than three parts per centum of salt.

(2) The meat used shall be of good colour and shall be properly trimmed free of excess fat, blood clots, bruises, bone, skin, gristle, fibrous tissue, glands, tendons, serous membranes, and coarse connective tissue.

(3) No container of canned meat or canned meat product shall be sold until examined by the manufacturer not less than five days after the canning process has been completed. Containers showing any abnormality shall be rejected.

(4) Containers found to be leaky or faulty after heat processing shall not be re-processed except under the following conditions—

- (a) that such re-processing be conducted within six hours of the original processing; or
- (b) if discovered during the latter part of the day, that the containers be held over until the following morning in a room the temperature of which does not exceed 40° F.

Containers not re-processed as provided above shall be destroyed.

(5) The use of jelly in excess of one part of jelly to every 24 parts of meat, sausages, or meat products, except in the case of canned tongues, trotters, and galantine meats, is prohibited.

Canned Meat with Cereal.

(6) Canned meat or meats with cereal and condiments only, except where designated in the label attached to the container as 'Pie', shall contain not more than 6 parts per centum of starch, and not less than 80 parts per centum of meat (when determined by the prescribed method) of the kind or kinds designated in the label.

(7) Canned meat or meats with cereal and condiments only, where designated in the label attached to the container as 'Pie', shall contain not more than 7 parts per centum of starch and not less than 51 parts per centum of meat (when determined by the prescribed method) of the kind or kinds designated in the label.

Canned Meat with Vegetables.

(8) Canned meat or meats with vegetables, where meats are or a variety of meat is first named in the label attached to the container, shall contain not less than 51 parts per centum of meat (when determined by the prescribed method) of the kind or kinds designated in the label.

Canned Meat with Pastry.

(9) Canned meat or meats with pastry, where meats are or a variety of meat is first named in the label attached to the container, shall contain not less than 51 parts per centum of meat (when determined by the prescribed method) of the kind or kinds designated in the label.

Canned Sausages.

(10) Canned sausages shall contain not more than 6 parts per centum of starch and not less than 75 parts per centum of meat (when determined by the prescribed method) of the kind or kinds designated in the label attached to the container.

Canned Sausages with Vegetables.

(11) Canned sausages with vegetables, where sausages are or a variety of sausage is first named in the label attached to the container, shall contain not less than 51 parts per centum of sausages (when determined by the prescribed method).

Canned Sausages with Tomato Sauce, &c.

(12) Canned sausages with tomato sauce, curry, or other similar substance, where sausages are or a variety of sausage is first named in the label attached to the container, shall contain not less than 75 parts per centum of sausages (when determined by the prescribed method).

Fat Content.

(13) (a) The fat content of canned corned brisket, canned pork sausages, canned ham loaf, and other canned meat or meat products of which pork is the main constituent, shall not exceed 30 parts per centum of the total meat content.

(b) The fat content of canned bacon shall not exceed 50 parts per centum of the total meat content.

(c) The fat content of any other canned meat or meat product shall not exceed 20 parts per centum of the total meat content.

Labelling.

(14) Every person who sells any package which contains canned meat or meats or meat products shall attach thereto a label in which shall be written in letters of not less than six points a statement that either the meat contents have been cooked before canning, or partially cooked before canning, or that the meat contents have been cooked in the container with retention of the natural meat juices, as in the following form:—

MEAT COOKED BEFORE CANNING

or

MEAT PARTIALLY COOKED BEFORE CANNING

or

MEAT COOKED IN CAN WITH RETENTION OF MEAT JUICE

or, alternatively, where the meat contents have been cooked before canning, such fact may be indicated by the use of the letter C, where the meat contents have been partially cooked before canning, such fact may be indicated by the use of the letter P and, where the meat contents have been cooked in the container, such fact may be indicated by the use of the letter N in letters of not less than eight points immediately following the trade name or description in the label on or attached to the container.

(15) Every person who sells any package which contains canned meat or meats or sausages shall attach thereto a label in which shall be written—

(a) in letters of not less than eighteen points a statement giving a true description of the contents of such container as in the following examples:—

CORNED BEEF

or

VEAL AND PORK

Where the article is prepared from two or more kinds of meat, the first named in the label shall be in greater proportion than any other; and

(b) in letters of not less than six points a statement of the approximate proportion of each kind of meat present as in the following example:—

CONTAINS 80 PER CENT. VEAL AND 20 PER CENT. PORK.

(16) Every person who sells any package which contains canned meat, meats or sausages with cereals, vegetables, pastry, or similar commodities, shall attach thereto a label in which shall be written—

(a) in letters of not less than eighteen points a true description of the contents of the container as in the following examples :—

CORNED BEEF WITH CEREAL

or

VEAL AND PORK WITH VEGETABLES

or

BEEF STEAK AND KIDNEY PUDDING

and

(b) in letters of not less than six points a statement of the approximate proportion of each ingredient present as in the following examples :—

CONTAINS 80 PER CENT. CORNED BEEF AND
10 PER CENT. CEREAL

or

CONTAINS 50 PER CENT. VEAL, 16 PER CENT. PORK,
CARROTS, POTATOES, PEAS

or

CONTAINS 60 PER CENT. BEEF, 6 PER CENT. KIDNEY,
30 PER CENT. PASTRY.

The three main vegetables shall be stated in descending order of the proportions present."

5. Paragraph (c) of sub-regulation (5) of Regulation 33 of the Food and Drug Standards Regulations 1939 is hereby amended by substituting for the words "UNFIT FOR INFANTS" the words "UNSUITABLE FOR BABIES EXCEPT ON MEDICAL ADVICE".

6. Paragraph (a) of sub-regulation (7) of Regulation 35 of the Food and Drug Standards Regulations 1939 is hereby amended by—

(a) substituting for the words "UNFIT FOR INFANTS" the words "UNSUITABLE FOR BABIES EXCEPT ON MEDICAL ADVICE".

(b) deleting the words "in such colours as to afford a distinct colour contrast to the ground".

7. Sub-regulation (3) of Regulation 58 of the Food and Drug Standards Regulations 1939 is hereby amended by substituting for the words "sodium alginate in proportion not exceeding 0.1 parts per centum" the words "sodium alginate in proportion not exceeding 0.3 parts per centum".

8. Sub-regulation (1) of Regulation 60 of the Food and Drug Standards Regulations 1939 is hereby amended by inserting the following statement at the end of paragraph (a):—"They may contain sodium alginate in proportion not exceeding 0.3 parts per centum".

9. Sub-regulation (1) of Regulation 62 of the Food and Drug Standards Regulations 1939 is hereby amended by substituting for the words "sodium alginate in proportion not exceeding 0.1 parts per centum" the words "sodium alginate in proportion not exceeding 0.3 parts per centum".

10. Regulation 63 of the Food and Drug Standards Regulations 1939 is hereby amended by inserting the following statement at the end of sub-regulations (1) and (2):—"They may contain sodium alginate in proportion not exceeding 0.3 parts per centum".

11. Paragraph (b) of sub-regulation (9) of Regulation 76 of the Food and Drug Standards Regulations 1939 is hereby repealed, and the following substituted therefor:—

"(b) Nothing in this Part shall be deemed to extend or apply to any advertisement which is published or distributed only to members of the medical, dental, pharmaceutical, dietetic, or nursing professions or which is published only in bona fide professional or trade journals ordinarily circulating only among such members."

12. Immediately after paragraph (2A) of Regulation 84 of the Food and Drug Standards Regulations 1939 the following heading and paragraph shall be inserted :—

“ Labelling of preparations containing Chlordane.

(2B) (a) Every person who sells any package which contains or purports to contain an insecticide shall when such package contains chlordane (octachloro-methane-tetrahydroindane or octachlorodicyclo-pentadiene-dihydride) include in the label attached to such package—

(i) a statement of the percentage of chlordane in such preparation ;

(ii) the following warning :—

‘ NOT TO BE USED for spraying into the air as for flies nor for general application to large areas nor for spraying bedding. When used indoors, apply directly with a brush or swab. Avoid inhalation or contact with skin or foodstuffs.’

(b) No person shall sell any insecticide containing chlordane for general household use as a spray against flies, mosquitoes, moths, silver fish, &c.”

13. Regulation 101A of the Food and Drug Standards Regulations 1939 is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor :—

“ 101A. Determination of Meat in Sausage Meat and Sausages, Canned Meats, and Canned Meat Products and Meat Pies.

Preparation of Sample.

(1) Sausage Meat and Sausages.

In the case of sausages, separate the sausage meat as completely as possible from the casings. Weigh the whole sample of sausage meat and mix in a Waring Blendor (or similar apparatus) with a measured quantity of water to produce a homogeneous, semi-fluid mass. Make allowance for this dilution with water in all subsequent calculations.

(2) Canned Meat with Cereal.

Treat the whole sample as in (1).

(3) Canned Meat with Vegetables (or Pastry).

Using the whole sample, separate the meat as completely as possible from the vegetables (or pastry), weighing original sample and separated meat.

Treat the separated meat as in (1).

(4) Canned Sausages.

As in (1).

(5) Canned Sausages with Vegetables (or Tomato Sauce, &c.).

Using the whole sample, separate the sausages as completely as possible from the vegetables (or tomato sauce, &c.), weighing original sample and separated sausages.

Treat the separated sausages as in (1).

(6) Meat Pies.

Using the whole sample, separate the filling as completely as possible from the pastry, weighing original sample and separated filling.

Treat the separated filling as in (1).

Chemical Determinations.

Total Solids.

Place about 5 g. of ignited sand and a stirring rod in a flat-bottomed porcelain dish, dry thoroughly, cool in a desiccator, and weigh. Add prepared diluted sample (equivalent to from 3 to 5 g. of undiluted material), weigh accurately, mix with the sand, and heat to apparent dryness on a water bath, stirring at intervals. Complete drying at 100-102° C. weighing at hourly intervals until there is no significant loss of weight. Calculate percentage of total solids in undiluted sample.

Fat.

Weigh accurately a quantity of the prepared, diluted sample (equivalent to from 3 to 5 g. of undiluted material) into a Soxhlet thimble, stand thimble on a piece of cotton wool in a small beaker and dry overnight in oven at about 100° C. Place the cotton wool in top of thimble and transfer thimble to Soxhlet apparatus. Wash beaker several times with anhydrous ether, transferring ether to Soxhlet apparatus. Extract with anhydrous ether for sixteen hours, evaporate bulk of ether from Soxhlet flask and remove remainder on a water bath. Dry extracted fat at temperature of boiling water for 30 minutes, cool in desiccator and weigh.

Continue, at 30-minute intervals, this alternate drying and weighing until weight is constant. Remove fat from flask with petroleum ether, dry, cool, and weigh. Obtain weight of fat by difference.

Calculate percentage of fat in undiluted sample.

Nitrogen.

Weigh accurately a quantity of the prepared, diluted sample (equivalent to about 2 g. of the undiluted material) and determine the percentage of nitrogen by the Kjeldahl-Gunning-Arnold method.

Calculate percentage of nitrogen in the undiluted sample.

Total Protein.

Percentage of protein = percentage of N x 6.25.

Ash.

Weigh accurately a quantity of the prepared, diluted sample (equivalent to about 2.5 g. of the undiluted material) into an ignited and tared porcelain dish, ash at dull-red heat to constant weight.

Calculate percentage of ash in the undiluted sample.

Calculation of Percentage of Meat Protein in Undiluted Samples.

From the above determinations, make the following calculations:—

Non-fatty solids = total solids — fat.

Carbohydrate + crude cellulose = non-fatty solids — protein — ash.

Cereal filler = 2 x (carbohydrate + crude cellulose).

Nitrogen due to cereal filler = 1/100 x cereal filler.

Nitrogen due to meat = nitrogen as determined — nitrogen due to cereal filler.

Meat protein = nitrogen due to meat x 6.25.

Calculation of Meat Content.

(1) Sausage Meat and Sausages.

The percentage of meat is the percentage of meat protein x 4.8 in the case of beef or mutton or a mixture of both (or 4.6 in the case of sausage meat containing pork) plus the percentage of fat.

(2) Canned Meat with Cereal.

The percentage of meat is the percentage of meat protein x 4.8 if cooked in the can (or 4.2 if partially cooked before canning, or 3.5 if cooked before canning) plus the percentage of fat.

(3) Canned Meat with Vegetable (or Pastry).

The percentage of meat shall be calculated as in (2) and expressed as a percentage of the whole sample.

(4) Canned Sausages.

The percentage of meat is the percentage of meat protein x 4.8 plus the percentage of fat.

(5) Sausage Content in Canned Sausages with Vegetables (or Tomato Sauce, &c.).

The percentage of meat shall be calculated as in (4). The percentage of sausage is the percentage of meat x 1.3, expressed as a percentage of the whole sample.

(6) Meat Pies.

The percentage of meat is the percentage of meat protein x 5.1 plus the percentage of fat, expressed as a percentage of the whole pie.

And the Honourable William Peter Barry, Her Majesty's Minister of Health for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.

(d) Employees whom the employer has reasonable grounds for supposing are under the age of 21 years shall, if required, furnish proof of age by means of a birth certificate or statutory declaration by parent or guardian, upon which the employer shall be entitled to rely.

(e) Except as to the employment of apprentices to motor mechanics the proportion of male juniors who may be employed by any employer shall be one junior (whether he be an indentured apprentice, or an unapprenticed male junior) to every three adults employed in the shop or factory.

Prohibited Occupations.

(f) Junior employees shall not be employed—

- (i) If under the age of 16 years—on oil or gas burners or fires used for heating of small articles, or using electric arc or oxy acetylene blow pipe ; or
- (ii) If under 18 years of age—die setting on power presses ; as furnacemen or assistant furnacemen ; or as operators of power driven guillotines.

APPRENTICES.

Apprenticeship Trades.

5. (a) Minors, other than indentured apprentices, shall not be employed in the following occupations :—

- (i) Bodymaker (first class) and/or wheelmaker and wheelwright in wood and/or metal and or substitutes.
- (ii) Fitter and/or turner.
- (iii) Metal machinist (first class).
- (iv) Motor mechanic (as defined).
- (v) Painter (i.e., tradesman who mixes, matches, an applies paint).
- (vi) Patternmaker.
- (vii) Saw Doctor.
- (viii) Smith, including coachsmith, spring maker and spring fitter, wheelwright smith and general smith.
- (ix) Tradesman panel worker and panel beater.
- (x) Trimmer, development and/or repair work.
- (xi) Trimmer tradesman on production.
- (xii) Welder (tradesman).
- (xiii) Wood machinist (first class).

Contract of Apprenticeship.

(b) Every contract of apprenticeship hereinafter made shall contain—

- (i) the names of the parties ;
- (ii) the date of birth of the apprentice ;
- (iii) a statement of the trade or trades to which the apprenticeship is to be bound and which he is to be taught during the course and for the purpose of the apprenticeship ;
- (iv) a covenant by the master to teach and instruct or cause the apprentice to be taught or to be instructed in the trade to which the apprentice is bound ;
- (v) the date at which the apprenticeship is to commence or from which it is to be calculated ;
- (vi) all other conditions of apprenticeship.

Proportion.

(c) The proportion of apprentices that may be taken by any employer shall be one to three or fraction of three tradesmen in each section of the industry, except that in the case of motor mechanics the proportions shall be one apprentice to two mechanics.

The number of tradesmen shall be deemed to be the average number working during the immediately preceding six months, and in ascertaining such proportion an employer actually working in any workshop shall be deemed to be a tradesman.

A person who, for a period not exceeding two years, is taking practical training in a workshop in continuance of a course of training for professional work, shall not be taken into account in calculating the proportion of apprentices to journeymen.

Period of Apprenticeship.

(d) The periods of apprenticeship shall be as follows :—

- If the apprentice when articulated is under the age of 17 years 5 years
- If over the age of 17 years 4 years or 5 years at the option of the contracting parties.

Minors may be taken on probation for three months, and if apprenticed such three months shall count as part of period of apprenticeship.

Instruction in Welding.

(e) The training of apprentices to smithing, fitting and/or turning, or panel working shall include instruction in electric welding and/or oxy-acetylene welding as far as is practicable with the facilities available in the shop in which they are trained.

The training of apprentices to body-making shall include sufficient instruction in welding to enable them to perform the work of their trade in the shop in which they are trained.

The total wages of apprentices shall be calculated to the nearest 6d., any broken part of 6d. in the result not exceeding 3d. to be disregarded.

The sum of 4s. per week shall be added to the above rates in the case of apprentices patternmakers.

Apprentices to body making first-class shall be supplied by their employers at the end of each quarter with an order for a sum equivalent to 2s. 6d. per week as a tool allowance.

Apprentices to panel working and panel beating shall be supplied by their employers at the end of each year of their apprenticeship with an order for a sum equivalent to 1s. 3d. per week, as a tool allowance.

An employee who is under 21 years of age at the expiration of his apprenticeship and thereafter works as a minor in the occupation to which he has been apprenticed shall be paid at not less than the adult rate prescribed for that classification.

Sick Leave, Public Holidays and Annual Leave.

(g) Apprentices shall be entitled to sick leave, public holidays and annual leave as prescribed by clauses 8, 13, and 14 of this Determination.

Hours.

(h) The ordinary hours of employment of apprentices shall, be the same in each workshop as those of journeymen.

Overtime and Shift Work.

(i) Where practicable, no apprentice under the age of 18 years shall be required to work overtime or shift work at times which would prevent his attendance at technical school as required by any statute, or regulation applicable to him.

Payment by Results.

(j) No apprentice shall work under any system of payment by results.

Adult Apprentices.

(k) Any apprentice who cannot complete his full term of apprenticeship before reaching his 21st birthday may with the approval of the Secretary for Labour serve as an apprentice until he reaches the age of 23 years.

Lost Time.

(l) An apprentice at the end of the calendar period of any year in which he has actually given service to the employer upon less than the ordinary working days prescribed in the Determination for the trade or in which he has unlawfully absented himself without the employer's consent may, for every day short of the said number of working days and for every day of such absence, be required by his employer to serve one day, in which case the calendar period of the succeeding year of his service shall not be deemed to begin until the said additional day or days shall have been served, provided that in calculating the extra time to be so served, the apprentice shall be credited with time which he has worked during the relevant years in excess of his ordinary hours.

Prohibition of Premiums.

(m) No employer shall either directly or indirectly or by any pretence or device receive from any person or require or permit any person to pay or give any consideration in the nature of a premium or bonus for the taking or binding of any probationer or apprentice.

Attendance at Technical Schools.

(n) Apprentices attending technical colleges or schools and presenting reports of satisfactory conduct shall be reimbursed all fees paid by them.

Clauses, other than clauses 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Determination shall remain in force.

**DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE
FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).**

PROPORTION (IN ANY PLACE).

(a) Apprentices.

One apprentice to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than 32s. per week.

(b) Juvenile Workers.

One juvenile worker (i.e. a shop assistant not engaged in dispensing or compounding medicines, drugs or medicinal preparations, and who is under the age of 21 years) may be employed in any dispensary.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
