Provided that all other adult females employed on work for which a male margin of 40s. or over is prescribed shall receive a margin equal to 50 per centum of the male margin, but if the male margin is less than 40s., they shall receive a margin equal to 25 per centum of the male margin.

Where there is no male margin prescribed for their work they shall be paid a margin of 4s. per week.

PART III .-- SAVING.

No employee shall have his or her rate reduced merely as a result of this Determination.
