Clauses, other than clauses 2 and 17, of the said Determination shall remain in force, provided that, to the weekly earnings of each piece-worker shall be added the sum of seven shillings. Where less than forty hours is worked in any week by any piece-worker, a proportionate amount of such sum of seven shillings shall be added in lieu thereof.
