# DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 33 OF THE LABOUR AND INDUSTRY ACT 1953.

Where less than 40 hours is worked in any week by any pieceworker, a proportionate amount of such sum of six shillings shall be added in lieu thereof.
