Labour and Industry Act 1953.

DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 33 OF THE LABOUR AND INDUSTRY ACT 1953.

Proportion (within any factory or place).

Apprentices.

One male apprentice to every three or fraction of three male workers receiving at wages rates or piece-work prices not less than 270s. per week.

One female apprentice to every three or fraction of three female workers receiving at wages rates or piece-work prices not less than 195s. 6d. per week.

Improvers.

One male improver to every three or fraction of three male workers receiving at wages rates or piece-work prices not less than 270s. per week.

One female improver to every three or fraction of three female workers receiving not less than 195s. 6d. per week.

Clauses, other than clause 2 of the said Determination, shall remain in force.
