Feather Duster Making Section.

Mop Making Section.

Two male improvers to every worker receiving not less than 267s. 9d. per week of 40 hours.
 Two female improvers to every female worker receiving not less than 195s. 6d. per week of 40 hours.

Broom Section.

One improver to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than 267s. 9d. per week of 40 hours, or the prescribed piece-work prices.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force provided that in clause 15 the amount of 164s. 9d. wherever appearing shall be increased to 169s. 9d.
