Labour and Industry Act 1953.

AMENDING DETERMINATION OF THE FLOCK BOARD.

NOTE.—(a) This Determination applies to the whole of the State of Victoria.

IN accordance with the provisions of the *Labour and Industry Act 1953*, the Wages Board which now has the power to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons employed—

- (a) in the process, trade, or business of—
 - (i) making flock, mungo, felt, or wadding;
 - (ii) cleaning wool by beating, blowing, or similar machines where such work is not subject to the Determination of any Wages Board heretofore appointed;
- (b) in connexion with any process, trade, or business set out in paragraph (a)—
 - (i) as a storeman, packer, or sorter;
 - (ii) in assisting a storeman, packer, or sorter;
 - (iii) as an assembler, collector, or checker of goods in course of receipt or despatch—

has made the following Determination, namely :—

That as from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in September, 1955, the Determination made on the 16th May, 1955, and in force as from the beginning of the first pay period to commence on or after the 19th May, 1955, shall be amended by adding to clause 2 "Other Employees" the following classification and wage rate :—

" Operators of low or high production garnetts fitted with variable Lappers or long folders 275s. "
