## DETERMINATION OF THE INDUSTRIAL APPEALS COURT:

IN THE MATTER of the Labour and Industry Acts.

AND

IN THE MATTER of a DETERMINATION OF THE BUILDERS' LABOURERS BOARD made on the 8th day of May, 1956.

AND

IN THE MATTER of APPEALS against the said Determination.

Before the Industrial Appeals Court (Judge Gamble, K. H. Boykett, Esq., and M. C. Jordan, Esq.)

Monday the 6th day of August, 1956.

Having heard the abovementioned Appeals on the 3rd., 4th., and 5th days of July, 1956, on this day this Court doth order and determine:—

1. That the employers appeal be dismissed in part and the matter referred back to the Wages Board;
2. That the Wages Rates appearing in Clause 1 (a) of Part 1 and in Clause 1 (a) of Part 2 of the Determination appealed against be adjusted in accordance with the provisions of Part 3 to read as follows:—

### PART 1.

For skilled builders' labourers ..	..	..	..	..	..	8s. 6½d. per hour.
For ordinary builders' labourers ..	..	..	..	..	..	8s. 0½d. per hour.

### PART 2.

Builders' labourer ..	..	Higher Grade	..	..	..	£15·13·6.
Builders' labourer ..	..	Lower Grade	..	..	..	£14·13·6.

3. That the Determination appealed against, as adjusted, shall come into operation from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in August, 1956.
