<sup>(</sup>c) When shift work is performed the rates prescribed in clause 2 (b) hereof for day work shall be increased as follows:—
(i) by 7½ per cent. for all work done during the afternoon shift; and
(ii) by 10 per cent. for all work done during the night shift.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination as amended shall remain in force provided that an employee when engaged in diving shall receive the sum of £2 6s. 6d. per dive in lieu of his ordinary rate. A dive shall cover all time up to half a day including preparation before and after the dive.
