Labour and Industry Acts.

AMENDING DETERMINATION OF THE MARINE STORES BOARD.

NOTE.—This Determination applies to the whole of the State of Victoria.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Labour and Industry Acts, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates of payment which may be paid to any persons or person or classes of persons employed either inside or outside a factory in the process, trade, or business of a marine store dealer or a dealer in old metals or bottles" has made the following Determination namely:—

That, as from the 11th September, 1956, a new clause shall be inserted in the Determination published in *Government Gazette* No. 222 of the 12th April, 1954, as follows—

9a. Olympic Day, 22nd November, 1956 (within such area as may be proclaimed by Order in Council), shall be deemed to be included in the list of holidays herein prescribed in clause 9. Provided that any employee who fails to attend for work on the working day before and/or after such holiday without reasonable excuse, shall not be entitled to be paid for such holiday.
