THE ROYAL ASSENT TO AN ACT SHORTLY ENTITLED THE GOVERNOR'S SALARY ACT 1956.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

I THE Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, in pursuance of the provisions contained in the Australian States Constitution Act 1907 (7 Edw. 7 C.7), do by this my Proclamation signify that the Bill the title whereof is herein set forth, that is to say—

No. 6056. "An Act to amend Section Ten of the Constitution Act Amendment Act 1956"—

which was reserved for the signification of Her Majesty's pleasure thereon, has been laid before Her Majesty in Council and that by an Order in Council bearing date the nineteenth day of December, 1956, Her Majesty has been pleased to assent to same.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria this nineteenth day of December, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and fifty-six, and in the fifth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
