**DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO
SECTION 33 OF THE LABOUR AND INDUSTRY ACT 1953.**

GENERAL BOARD.

NOTE.—The rates prescribed for improvers shall apply only to such employees as are under 21 years of age, or who, being over 21 years of age, are the holders of improvers' licences.

PROPORTION (IN ANY PLACE).

Males.

One male improver to each male person receiving not less than the minimum wage.

Females.

Three female improvers to the first female person receiving not less than the minimum wage; thereafter one additional improver to each additional female person receiving not less than the minimum wage.

Males.

Adults (i) Of three months' or more experience .. 258 0

(ii) Of less than three months' experience 254 0

Females.

(a) Designer of patterns to be used for producing articles of wearing apparel .. 274 3

(b) Assistant to (a) above .. 222 9

(c) Designers of patterns used for the production of transfers as applied to fabrics .. 222 9

(d) Assistants to (c) above .. 195 9

(e) Operator of perforating machine .. 188 0

(f) Any other adult .. 188 0

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination for this Section shall remain in force.
