DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 33 OF THE LABOUR AND INDUSTRY ACT 1953.

PROPORTION (WITHIN ANY PLACE).

One apprentice or one improver to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than the minimum wage. (a) Employed within the Metropolitan District as defined in the Labour and Industry Act 1953, and at Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Warrnambool, Castlemaine, Yallourn, and Frankston, and within the Gippsland district:—

Other Employees.

- All Employees £15 15s. per week of 40 hours.
- (b) Employed outside the areas specified in paragraph (a):— All Employees £15 12s. per week of 40 hours.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
