DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 33 OF THE LABOUR AND INDUSTRY ACT 1953.

PIECEWORK.

22. The lowest piecework prices payable to any person engaged in the following kinds of work shall be:—

Skinning rabbits (heads off)	7s. 0·4d. per 100
Skinning rabbits (heads on)	9s. 4·2d. per 100
Skinning hares	27s. 5·3d. per 100
Boning rabbit or hares (including washing weighing and taking in and out of chamber)	2·9845d. per lb.

Clauses, other than clauses 2 and 22, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
