LEADING HANDS.

A Leading Hand shall be paid the Wages hereinbefore prescribed for a Sinker (other than a manhole sinker) with three months' experience or over plus the following additional amount:—

- (i) if in charge of three to ten employees 15s;
- (ii) if in charge of more than ten employees 30s.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
