Labour and Industry Act 1953.

AMENDING DETERMINATION OF THE SHOPS BOARD No. 8
(DAIRY PRODUCE AND COOKED MEAT).

NOTE.—This Determination applies to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Labour and Industry Act; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong West, Warrnambool, and Newtown and Chilwell; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk and Sebastopol.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Labour and Industry Act, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons employed in the trade of a seller of Dairy Produce or Cooked Meat," has made the following Determination, namely:—

That as from the 28th September, 1955, Clause 9A of the Determination made on the 13th July, 1955, and in force as from the first pay period to commence in August, 1955, shall be replaced by the following clause:—

PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.

9A. New Year's Day, Australia Day, Labour Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Queen's Birthday, Christmas Day, and Boxing Day, and within the Metropolitan District Melbourne Cup Day, or any day by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the said days shall be observed as Public Holidays.
