DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 33 OF THE LABOUR AND INDUSTRY ACT 1953.

IMPROVERS.

Mop Making Section.

Two male improvers to every worker receiving not less than 283s. 9d. per week of 40 hours.

Two female improvers to every female worker receiving not less than 207s. 6d. per week of 40 hours.

Broom Section.

One improver to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than 283s. 9d. per week of 40 hours, or the prescribed piece-work prices.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force provided that in clause 15 the amount of 164s. 9d. wherever appearing shall be increased to 185s. 9d.
