Labour and Industry Acts.

DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 33 OF THE LABOUR AND INDUSTRY ACT 1953.

I, Henry Norman Jones, Secretary for Labour and Industry, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Labour and Industry Acts, hereby make and issue the following adjusted Determination of the Wages Board referred to hereunder showing adjusted rates and prices to operate from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in May, 1956.

50. Men engaged skimming settling pits, shall be paid at the rate of 6d. per hour in addition to their ordinary overtime rate whilst engaged on such work	
51. Men employed cleaning or scraping the inside of booby tanks or digestors shall be paid at the rate of 6d. per hour in addition to their ordinary or overtime rate whilst engaged on such work	
52. An employee who is required to work in the oil and tallow plant for at least 15 consecutive minutes and in a temperature of 35 degrees fahrenheit or below shall be paid 3d. per hour in addition to his ordinary or overtime or penalty rate of pay and shall be so paid as for a minimum of two hours during each day.
