DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 33 OF THE LABOUR AND INDUSTRY ACT 1953.

DISPENSARIES BOARD.

PROPORTION (IN ANY PLACE).

(a) Unregistered Assistants.

One unregistered assistant to every three or fraction of three Pharmaceutical Chemists receiving not less than £21 10s. 6d. per week.

(b) Apprentices.

One apprentice to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than £21 10s. 6d. per week.

(c) Juvenile Workers.

One juvenile worker (i.e., a shop assistant not engaged in dispensing or compounding medicines, drugs, or medicinal preparations, and who is under the age of 21 years) may be employed in any dispensary.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
