Labour and Industry Acts.

AMENDING DETERMINATION OF THE SAND PIT BOARD.

NOTE.—This Determination applies to the whole of the State of Victoria.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Labour and Industry Acts, the Wages Board which since the 2nd October, 1939, has had the power to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons employed in connexion with—A sand pit at labouring work, excavating, handling, or removing sand for trade or sale, or excavating, handling, or removing sand for the construction or the maintenance of roads, but not including persons subject to the jurisdiction of the Carters Board," has made the following Determination, namely:—

That, as from the 17th September, 1956, the Determination published in *Government Gazette*, No. 312 of the 30th April, 1954, shall be amended by the deletion of clause 8A, and the substitution in lieu of the following clause:—

8A. In connexion with the holding of the Olympic Games in Victoria, during the months of November, and December, 1956, where a holiday or half-holiday is proclaimed by Order in Council throughout any Municipality or part thereof, or within any defined area, such holiday or half-holiday shall, so far as such Municipality or part thereof, or such defined area is concerned be deemed to be included in the list of holidays prescribed in clauses 7 and 8.

Provided that no employee shall be entitled to the conditions prescribed by this clause for more than the equivalent of one working day.

Provided further that an employee who fails to attend for work on the working day before and/or after such holiday or half-holiday without reasonable excuse shall not be entitled to be paid for such holiday or half-holiday.
