Labour and Industry Acts.

AMENDING DETERMINATION OF THE BUTTER FACTORIES BOARD.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Labour and Industry Acts, the Butter Factories Board has made the following amending Determination, namely:—

That, on the 21st November, 1956, the Determination made on the 14th June, 1956, and in force as from the beginning of the first pay period to commence on or after the 28th June, 1956, shall be amended by deleting clause 23 (c) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:—

- (c) In connexion with the holding of the Olympic Games in Victoria, during the months of November, and December, 1956, where a holiday or half-holiday is proclaimed by Order in Council throughout any Municipality or part thereof, or within any defined area, such holiday or half-holiday shall, so far as such Municipality or part thereof, or such defined area is concerned be deemed to be included in the list of holidays prescribed in clause 23 hereof.

No employee shall be entitled to the conditions prescribed by this clause for more than the equivalent of one working day.

Provided that an employee who fails to attend for work on the working day before and/or after such holiday or half-holiday without reasonable excuse shall not be entitled to be paid for such holiday or half-holiday.

Provided further that by agreement between any employer and his employees another day or half-day may be substituted during the period of the 1956 Olympic Games—22nd November, 1956, to 8th December, 1956, for the day or half day as the case may be proclaimed for the locality in which the employer's undertaking is situated.
