DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION OF ACT.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the seventh year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, entitled the *Snowy Mountains Hydro-Electric Agreements Act 1958* (No. 6180), it is amongst other things enacted that the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*: Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation fix Tuesday, the twenty-fifth day of November, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-eight, as the day upon which the said Act shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this twenty-fifth day of November, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and fifty-eight, and in the seventh year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
