PROHIBITION OF THE USE OF NETS FOR TAKING OR CAPTURING NATIVE GAME.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

I THE Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, and in pursuance of the provisions of the Game Acts and all other powers me enabling in that behalf, do by this my Proclamation prohibit the use of nets of any kind whatsoever for the taking or capture of or for attempting or assisting to take or capture any species of native game, and I do further prescribe a sum not exceeding Twenty pounds as the penalty for any contravention of this Proclamation.

SANCTUARY FOR NATIVE GAME AT LITTLE SNAKE ISLAND.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

I THE Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, and in pursuance of the provisions of the Game Acts and all other powers me enabling in that behalf do by this my Proclamation direct that the part of Victoria hereinafter described shall be a locality in which from the first day of January to the thirty-first day of December (both days inclusive) in each year, it shall be unlawful for any person to kill or destroy any native game included in the Third Schedule to the *Game Act 1928*.
