GAS REGULATION ACT 1958.

SPECIFYING OF THE GAS SUPPLY COMPANY LIMITED (IN RESPECT OF THE WODONGA PORTION OF ITS UNDERTAKING) AS AN UNDERTAKER.

WHEREAS it is provided in paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section 4 of the Gas Regulation Act 1958, that the undertakers to which this Act applies are every undertaker which for a continuous period of twelve months next preceding the thirtieth day of June in any year after the commencement of this Act sells more than twenty-five million cubic feet of gas and the name of

which is specified by Order in Council under that section: And whereas The Gas Supply Company Limited (in respect of the Wodonga portion of its undertaking) during the continuous period of twelve months next preceding the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and sixty, did sell twenty-six million, five hundred and eighteen thousand, three hundred cubic feet of gas. of gas:

Now therefore, His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, and in pursuance of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of section 4 of the Gas Regulation Act 1958, doth by this Order specify The Gas Supply Company Limited (in respect of the Wodonga portion of its undertaking) as an undertaker to which the Gas Regulation Act 1958 shall apply, as from the first day of January, 1961.

And the Honorable Arthur Gordon Rylah, Her Majesty's Chief Secretary for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
