## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Administrator of the Government of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions of the Bank Holidays Act 1958, I, the Administrator of the Government of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation appoint the day and date named hereunder a special day to be observed as a Bank Half-Holiday at the place mentioned, that is to

Bank Half-Holiday from the Hour of Eleven a.m.:— MONDAY, THE 27TH MARCH, 1961, at Ballan.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this twentythird day of March, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and sixty-one, and in the tenth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
