ELECTION OF SENATORS FOR VICTORIA.

**H**IS Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, and in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Senate Elections Act 1958*, doth by this Order fix the following dates for the purpose of the election of Senators for Victoria of the Parliament of the Commonwealth, viz.:—

The issue of the writ—26th October, 1964.

The nomination of the candidates—9th November, 1964.

The polling—5th December, 1964.

The return of the writ—on or before the 23rd January, 1965.

And doth appoint the Commonwealth Electoral Office, 301 Flinders-lane, at Melbourne, to be the place for the nomination of candidates.

And the Honorable Arthur Gordon Rylah, Her Majesty's Chief Secretary for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
