## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by section 1 (3) of the Stamps Act 1967 (No. 7585) it is provided that the said Act shall come into operation on a day or the respective days to be fixed by proclamation or successive proclamations of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette:

NOW THEREFORE I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State do by this my Proclamation fix Friday the first day of December, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven, as the day on which Sections one, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine and ten of the said Stamps Act 1967 (No. 7585) shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this twenty-eighth day of November, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven, and in the sixteenth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
