PROCLAMATION

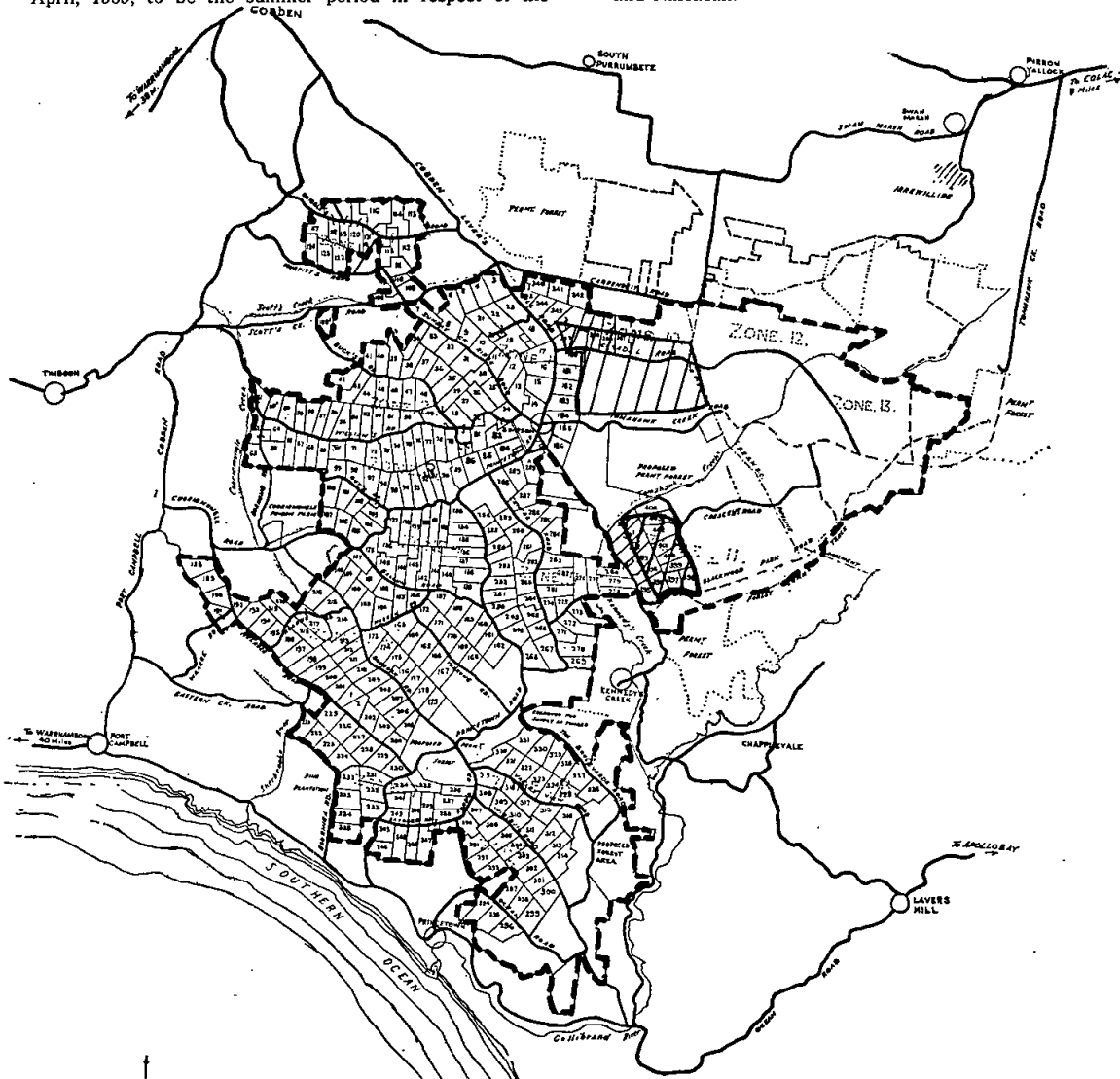

Now therefore I, the Chief Secretary of Victoria, do hereby declare the period commencing at midnight on the 20th December, 1968, and ending at midnight on the 30th April, 1969, to be the summer period in respect of the parts of the country area of Victoria specified in the Schedule hereunder; being the Fifth, Eighth, Sixteenth and Twenty-sixth Fire Control Regions, and portions of the Third, Sixth, Seventh, Ninth, Thirteenth, Fourteenth, Seventeenth, Nineteenth, Twenty-first and Twenty-third Fire Control Regions.

SCHEDULE (No. 9).
