DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act of Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the sixteenth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. intituled the *Crimes (Driving Offences) Act 1967 No. 7645*, it is amongst other things enacted that the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*: NOW THEREFORE I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my proclamation fix Friday the 1st day of March One thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight as the day upon which the *Crimes (Driving Offences) Act 1967 No. 7645* shall come into operation.

Given under my hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid at Melbourne this twenty-seventh day of February in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight and in the seventeenth year of the reign of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II.
